An Awareness Session on Thalassemia

- 14 Nov 2024



In a commendable effort to promote health awareness, Rotary Club of Navi Mumbai Hillside organized a Thalassemia Awareness Session for students on 14th November 2024. This educational event aimed to inform young individuals about Thalassemia, an inherited blood disorder that affects haemoglobin production, leading to severe anaemia. The goal was to educate students on the importance of early screening and preventive care. Rtn Prem Kumar and Rtn Nandita Das explained the causes, symptoms, and treatment of Thalassemia in their unique style, making students aware of the challenges faced by those affected. The session emphasized the significance of genetic screening and blood tests, especially for young adults who may be carriers without knowing. By understanding their genetic profile, individuals can make informed decisions regarding family planning and help prevent the condition from being passed to future generations.

In an effort to address the growing concern of substance abuse among youth, Rotary Club of Navi Mumbai Hillside recently held an awareness session focused on Drug Addiction Prevention. The program aimed to educate students about the dangers of drug addiction, its impact on mental and physical health, and ways to prevent and combat this critical issue. Rtn Amit Srivastav shared his insights into the causes, risks, and effects of drug abuse. He discussed how addiction can lead to severe health problems, disrupt families, and negatively impact society. He also emphasized the importance of making informed, healthy choices and resisting peer pressure, particularly among young people who are often more vulnerable to experimenting with drugs. The initiative, focused on providing sanitary napkins to adolescent girls, is part of the Rotary's ongoing efforts to promote women's health and break the stigma surrounding menstruation in rural areas. Menstrual hygiene is a crucial aspect of a young

girl's health and well-being. However, a lack of access to sanitary products and limited awareness continues to hinder many girls in rural areas, leading to health issues and absenteeism from school. The distribution drive included more than just handing out sanitary napkins. The event also included an engaging awareness session led by Dr Shyam More. Over 500 sanitary napkin packs were distributed to young girls aged 10 to 16, ensuring they have access to hygienic menstrual care for the coming months.
