STEPHANIE A. URCHICK, PRESIDENT, ROTARY INTERNATIONAL 2024-2025

Stephanie Urchick is partner and chief operating officer of Doctors at Work LLC, a consulting and training company. She holds a doctorate in leadership studies from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. She is active on numerous community boards and committees, and has been honored by organizations including Zonta International and the Sons of the American Revolution.

A Rotary member since 1991, Urchick has traveled to Vietnam to help build a primary school and to the Dominican Republic to install water filters. She studies several Slavic languages, has mentored new Rotarians in Ukraine, and coordinated a Rotary Foundation grant project in Poland.

Urchick has served Rotary in many roles, including as a director, Foundation trustee, and chair of the RI Strategic Planning Committee and the Foundation's Centennial Celebration Committee. She currently serves on the Election Review Committee and the Operations Review Committee. She is a Rotary Foundation Major Donor and a member of the Bequest Society.

In her own words, "Don't misunderstand me – we are not going to end polio or bring peace to the world by waving a wand and saying some funny words," Urchick told incoming district governors at the Rotary International Assembly on 8 January. "It's up to you. You create the magic with every project completed, every dollar donated, and every new member."





"The Magic of Rotary" is a theme that emphasizes the transformative power of Rotary International's work in communities around the world.



The Four-Way Test refers to better friendships, not more friendships. Better friendships are built on five attributes: respect, trust, reciprocity, shared experience, and mutual enjoyment of each other's company. If you desire better friendships, first examine if respect, trust, and reciprocity exist. One of the world's most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics is The Four-Way Test, which was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor (who later served as RI president) when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy.

In Rotary International, there are several acronyms and abbreviations used to refer to different positions, roles, and entities within the organization. Here are some of the commonly used shortforms and their meanings:

- DG District Governor: The chief officer of a Rotary district, responsible for supervising and supporting Rotary clubs within that district.
- DGE District Governor Elect: The person who has been elected to become the District Governor in the next Rotary year.
- DGN District Governor Nominee: The person nominated to become the District Governor two years hence.
- RID Rotary International Director: A member of the Rotary International Board of Directors, responsible for governing Rotary International.
- PRID Past Rotary International Director: Someone who has served as a Rotary International Director in the past.
- RVP Rotary International Vice President: An officer of Rotary International who assists the President in various duties.
- AG Assistant Governor: A Rotary club officer appointed by the District Governor to assist with clubs within a specific area of the district.
- PE President Elect: The incoming president of a Rotary club, elected to serve in the next Rotary year.
- PP Past President: A former president of a Rotary club.
- PDG Past District Governor: A former District Governor of a Rotary district.
- DGND District Governor Nominee Designate: The person selected to be the District Governor Nominee in the future, typically three years ahead.
- RAG Rotary Action Group: A group of Rotarians organized to focus on a specific area of humanitarian service.
- AKS Arch Klumph Society: A recognition society within Rotary International for individuals who have made significant financial contributions to the Rotary Foundation.

The Grand Recipes by Rtn. Prasanna Menon

EASY, REFRESHING CUCUMBER SALAD
INGREDIENTS:

- * 1 CUCUMBER (DICED)
- * 1/2 LEMON
- * 1 GREEN CHILLI (CHOPPED)
- * 2 TSP SESAME SEEDS
- * 1/4 CUP PUDINA (CHOPPED)
- * SALT (TO TASTE)

RECIPE:

- 1. ADD DICED CUCUMBER, CHOPPED CHILLI, SALT, LEMON JUICE AND PUDINA TO A BOWL. MIX WELL.
- 2. FRY SESAME SEEDS (WITHOUT OIL) AND ADD TO THE MIXTURE.
- 3. MIX WELL AND SERVE.





BEETROOT & KADALA STIR FRY

BEETROOT – 5 SMALL, CHOPPED (YOU CAN CHOP THEM IN A FOOD PROCESSOR)

BLACK CHICKPEAS / KADALA – 2 CUPS, COOKED (SOAK THEM IN ENOUGH WATER FOR AT LEAST 8 HRS AND PRESSURE COOK UNTIL DONE)

GRATED COCONUT – 1 CUP
TURMERIC POWDER – 1/2 TSP
CHILLY POWDER – 1 TSP
URAD DAL / UZHUNNU PARIPPU – 1.5 TSP
CURRY LEAVES – 1 – 2 SPRIGS
MUSTARD SEEDS – 1/2 TSP
DRY RED CHILLIES – 2 – 3
SALT – TO TASTE
COCONUT OIL – 1 TBSP



HEAT OIL IN A DEEP PAN AT MEDIUM HEAT. SPLUTTER MUSTARD SEEDS AND FRY DRY RED CHILLIES. ADD URAD DAL AND BROWN THEM. NOW ADD THE CHOPPED BEETROOT, ENOUGH SALT AND CURRY LEAVES. BRING DOWN THE HEAT. SPRINKLE 2 TBSP WATER. COVER AND COOK UNTIL DONE STIRRING OCCASIONALLY SO THAT IT DOES NOT STICK TO THE BOTTOM. IT TAKES ABOUT 10 – 15 MINUTES. ADD THE TURMERIC POWDER AND CHILLY POWDER. MIX WELL AND ADD THE GRATED COCONUT AND COOKED CHICKPEAS. STIR-FRY FOR A FEW MINUTES AND SWITCH OFF. SERVE WITH RICE AND AN OZHICHU CURRY.
