







First of all, many congratulations to RC Salem Gugai for successfully completing 40 years of Rotary service. In this 40th Ruby Jubilee year and during the Charter month, as a Charter Member of this prestigious Rotary Club of Salem Gugai it is my proud privilege and honour to share with you some of my insights about our club and also my experiences in our club through this monthly newsletter of our club.

The Beginning.

Let me share with you some interesting facts about the starting of our club.

In RY 1984-85, the then District Governor, our beloved PDG P.V.Purushothaman wanted to start a new club in Salem. Rotary Club of Salem North was given this responsibility.

The then North Club President Rtn Dr. Nagarajan alongwith club stalwarts like Rtn. Jayagopal, Rtn.M.H.Mehta and others meticulously searched and decided to start a new club in Gugai Salem. At that time there were six clubs in Salem meeting on six different days from Monday to Saturday and hence it was decided to have the meeting of the new club every Sunday morning, making our club the first breakfast club in the entire Zone at that time.

Unfortunately the Charter was delayed and was received only in RY 1985-86 when

Rtn Dr. Sundarraman was the District Governor.

Our club was chartered on 13th August 1985. With Rtn.K.P.Govindarajan as the Charter President, Rtn.Auditor Soundarrajan as the Charter Secretary and 21 members as the Charter Members, our club set out on this long journey and after 40 years is still going strong.

For 40 years our club has been doing great service to the society and to the community at large and today it stands tall as one of the most respected clubs in our district.

The Journey so far - Highlights

Let me also share with you some of the key highlights of our club's activities, projects, problems and challenges our club went through during these 40 years.

Our club is one of the very few clubs in our district to have produced Two Governors. Rtn.R.Govindarajan led the district as Governor in RY 2002-03 and Rtn. S.Loganathan, 25 years after our first Governor, will serve as the District Governor in RY 2027-28.

Our club is also one of the very few clubs in our district to possess our own land and meeting hall. Under the auspices of Rotary Club of Salem Gugai Charitable Trust a wonderful meeting hall and dining hall has been constructed which provides not only a meeting place but also serves as a source of income to our club.

The Erumapalayam Burial Ground project of our club is considered as one of the best community service project of our district. Completed at a cost of over Rs.25 lakhs in 2001–02 this project was appreciated by Rotary International and our club was presented with the coveted Significant Achievement Award in 2002–03.

Another popular and important project of our club was the Eye Camp conducted together with Madurai Aravind Eye Hospital continuously for more than 25 years. Thousands of poor people have benefited from this noble project. Our club has also received an Appreciation Award from Aravind Eye Hospital for this project.

Our club can boast itself for having the distinction of conducting almost all types of District Programs. Whether it is the District Conference, District Assembly, Pets & Sets, DTTS, District Seminars and even Multi District Seminars, our club has done it all. A feat that can be matched only by a handful of clubs in our district.

Apart from these, innumerable projects such as Medical camps, Polio Plus NIDs, Hepatitis B camps, Students Education Aids, Career Guidance Programs, Vocational Training Programs, School Development Projects, construction of Toilet Blocks for Public and Schools etc, etc the list goes on and on.

This 40 year journey of our club was not a walk in the park, it had its own share of problems, challenges and even faced a grave crisis in 2003-04 when our club was split due to the exit of some members. It was only the determination and resilience of our club and the members that we were able to sail past these troubled times and continue well.
