Birthing Kit Project Rotary Club of Mumbai South Cuffe Parade

Birthing Kit Project Rotary Club of Mumbai South Cuffe Parade Held at Ruxmani Lying-In Hospital – Babulnath Led by President Errick Elavia Conceptualised and spearheaded by Rtn Dr. Sujata Dalvi The Birthing Kit Project was completed with the heartfelt aim of offering dignity, comfort, and essential care to new mothers who had just delivered. Rooted in compassion and guided by the spirit of service, this initiative reflects the Club's commitment to supporting women at a tender and transformative moment in their lives.

A total of 20 birthing kits were thoughtfully assembled, each containing a sturdy handy bag, Dettol liquid, soap, Rajgira chikki, and iron and calcium tablets, which were graciously provided free of cost by supportive pharma partners .

In addition to the kits, a wide range of medicines and nutritional supplements was distributed. This support will continue as an ongoing effort, ensuring that mothers receive the vitamins and other essential post-delivery supplements required for their well-being in the crucial weeks ahead. The total project cost was ₹2,647 for all 20 fully stocked kits—demonstrating how meaningful impact can emerge through thoughtful planning, collaboration, and a spirit of collective care.

Alongside this, bone mineral densitometry was conducted for a total of 25 patients, free of cost, and relevant treatment advice was provided based on their results. This parallel initiative ensured that community members received timely insights into their bone health and guidance for further care. Together, these efforts highlight the Club's dedication to service, compassion, and upliftment of the community.






