But I request special support for two of my dream projects.

My first dream is for installing a full spectrum flow cytometry machine facility jointly with and at Tata memorial hospital that will help quick and accurate diagnosis of blood cancer and that would impact up to 2000 new cancer patients and upto approximately 8000 patients per year. This will create hope for cancer patients and their family and we will be able to wipe unshed tears of cancer patients and their families.

The cost of machine is around Rs. 2.5 crores. We are looking for international partner for this project and also global grants. But the basic funding should come from us. One of our Rotarian's family trust is likely to support this project with a donation of Rs. 1 crores. My second project is to help complete a junior college class rooms for tribal children in Kosbad, Palghar District. This will ensure better job opportunities and better life for tribal community.

Gyan dan is uttam daan. Even a small contribution from our members would total to a large sum. We look forward to you coming forward to support these 2 special projects close to my heart. I wish you and your family members a very Happy Deepawali and a prosperous New Year!

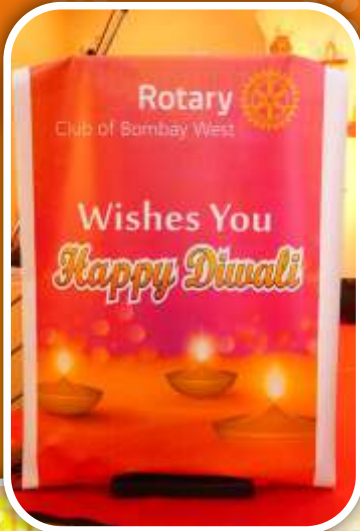
Participation by large number of members and anns. Every Gujarati is born garba dancer.
