Club President Dr Neelam Sethi and Secretary Dr Amit Modi discussed the Mentorship programme and involvement of new members in the forthcoming club projects.

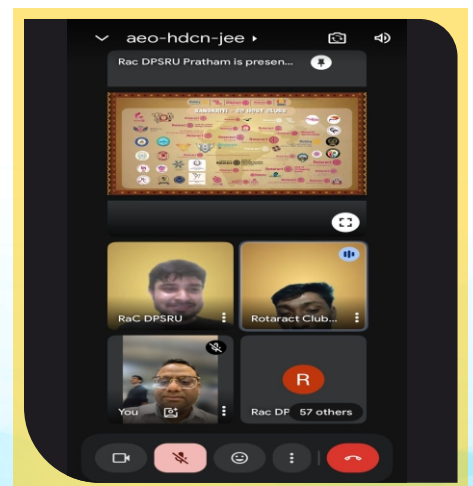


International Services – July 27, 2025.

Rights. He emphasised the importance of Meditation as it eliminates fears, thus enhancing quality of life. Seeds of peace need to be ingrained in the minds of the community.

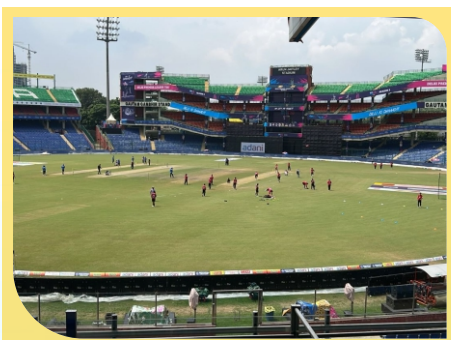

Fellowship and Speaker Meeting – August 24, 2025

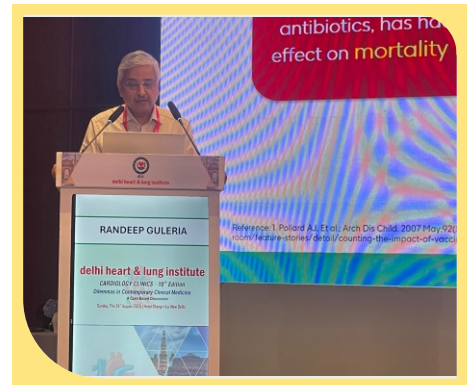
