





On October 8, 2024, RC Borivili proudly inaugurated the newly renovated Computer Lab and classrooms at Priyadarshini Vidya Mandir and Night Junior College in Charkop, Kandivali West. This significant upgrade modernized facilities that had dilapidated walls and noisy tin roofs, disrupting the learning experience. The renovations included replacing tin roofs with cement ceilings, enhancing acoustics and temperature control, and refurbishing the teachers' room and Computer Room. With new computers, the lab is now better equipped to serve the educational needs of the 400+ students enrolled in two shifts.

The ceremony featured Chief Guest DG Rtn. Chetan Desai and Guest of Honour PP Vinay Vyas. This project





ડી. હિતેશ છેડાએ જણાવ્યું કે, આયુષ્માન ભારત અને મહાત્મા ક્યોતિબા ફ્લે જન આરોગ્ય યોજના અંતર્ગત આંખના પડદા, ઝાયર, ગાંસી આંખ, વેલ, કીકીનું પ્રત્યારોપણનાં ઑપરેશન થાય છે પણ મોતિયાનાં ઑપરેશન આ યોજના હેઠળ થતાં નથી. મેં છેલ્લાં ચાર વર્ષમાં મોતિયાનાં બે હજાર ઓપરેશન રૂા. બે હજારમાં કર્યા છે, જેમાં અમુક સંસ્થાઓ કેમ્પ કરે તેમાં સંસ્થા કરળો આપે ત્યારે દર્દીનું ક્રી ઓપરેશન થઈ જાય છે. માનવતા કાઉન્ડેશનના ખુશાલ ગડા દરદીદીઠ રૂદ, ૧૦૦૦ કાળવે છે તેથી દરદીને રાહત મળે છે. તેમાં ગરીબ દરદી તોય તો અમે પોતે ક્રી કરી આપીએ છીએ.

કચ્છમાં ડૉ. હિતેશ છેડા પાર્સ એક વડીલે પોતાના પુત્રની આંખોની તપાસણી કરાવી તો ખબર પડી કે, પુત્રને પડદાની તકલીક છે અને તાત્કાલિક ઑપરેશનની જીર છે. બિદડા એશિયન તોસ્પિટલના સંચાલન મંગલભાઈ સંધારની બલામણથી દરદીને મુંબઈ લાલ્યા. બોરીવલી સ્ટેશને ડૉ. છેડાના માણસ હાજર હતા. તે હોસ્પિટલમાં લઈ આવ્યા. એક રૂમ આરામ માટે આપ્યો. પછી દરદીની આંખની તપાસ થઈ અને ઑપરેશન થયું. એ પછી ડોક્ટર, દર્દી અને તેના પિતાને પોતાના રૂમમાં રહેવાની સગવડ કરી આપી. પછી આંખો તપાસીને પરે જવાની રજા આપી. દરદીના પિતાએ બિલનું યૂછવું તો ડૉક્ટરે નમતાથી કહ્યું તમારા દીકરાની આંખ બરાબર થઈ જાય એ જ મારી કી છે. એ પછી ડો. છેડા રેલવે સ્ટેશન સુધી મૂકવા આવ્યા. ડૉ. છેડા બિદડા આવ્યા ત્યારે કરી દરદીની આંખો ચેકઅપ કરાવવા ગયા. તમે ઓપરેશન કી સ્વીકારવા કહ્યું ત્યારે જવાબમાં ડૉ. હિતેન છેડાએ કહ્યું તું વૈસા કમાવવા દર મહિને વતન નથી આવતો. વતનની સેવા માટે આવું છું. મુંબઈમાં પણ જે કચ્છથી દરદીઓ આવે છે તેમને મારા મહેમાનની જેમ રાખું છું.

A Simple Guide to Decoding

"Best Before", "Use By" & "Sell By" Dates in Food Packages

Food packages come with labels which mention the "best before" and "use by" dates. However, many of us may not be able to comprehend the import of these dates. It is therefore essential to understand the meaning of these labels - for our own health & safety, besides minimizing food wastage. Understanding the meaning of these labels will help us in making prudent choices while purchasing packaged food items.

Best Before Label:

- It is about the quality of the contents inside the package.
- The product would normally taste nice, and should, in the normal course, have the right texture.
- However, the food contents need to be stored as per the instructions mentioned on the label.

Use-By

- It is about food safety.
- One should not consume the contents after the expiry date is over.
- Don't cook, eat, or freeze the contents after the "use-by date".
- If kept for a longer period of time, the food contents may smell or look fine, but may have developed bacteria, rendering them unsafe to consume.

Suggestion: It is always safer to opt for home cooked food. However, where necessary, one may have to purchase packaged foods. In such cases, it is always prudent to purchase edibles which are closest to the manufacturing date- in other words, as recent as possible.

Sell By

- Sell by dates are meant_for those who sell/ market packaged foods.
- They should not stock or sell food items which are past the "sell by" date.

In conclusion - one should be extremely mindful of the above dates while purchasing packaged food items. Do remember - Our Health is in our Hands.


