

There being no other points, the meeting was declared closed. All members thanked the host and hostess for their largesse.











The Red Pill

There are many philosophers, politicians, notable internet celebrities, and prominent figures in society who have openly stated their belief in the "Red Pill Theory" but how can one conspiracy been so widely and openly believed in? Is there some truth to it? What do we have to do to take the 'red pill' and what does it even mean?

The term 'red pill' comes from the highly acclaimed film, the matrix. It stems from the idea that we are living in a computer simulation; that in order to know the truth, one has to take the red pill, and that way you can see the world for what it truly is. The basic idea being we are living in a false reality, and in order to escape these illusions we must think beyond what is taught.

If we look back to the earlier philosophers of the western world, we find Plato and his beliefs in the birth of reality. In one of his most famous works, named 'The Republic', he depicts the renowned allegory of the cave in which he illustrates a world in which the humans are residing in a cave, watching what is like a puppet show created by shadows. These humans believe this to be their reality and know nothing outside of this; they are completely ignorant. With their necks and legs bound by shackles, they cannot and have never moved from their position. Then one day one of these 'prisoners' so to speak, escaped from his chains and finally arrived face to face with the 'real world'. At first, staring into this foreign 'sun', he is blinded by the light; with eyes struggling to adjust. But after becoming accustomed to this new reality, he decides upon spreading the truth to the habitants of the cave. Alas, when he goes back down, his eyes had already adjusted to the bright light so cannot see the shadows any more. Meaning, when he tried to convince the prisoners of the world above, he is unsuccessful. This is because they come to the conclusion that when you ascend the cave, you lose your eyesight and so are no longer able to live in the cave, not realizing that they are the ones who are in fact blind.

It could be argued that The Red Pill symbolizes a medicine, in order to free oneself from their shackles. It is widely believed that the answer is simply critical thinking and a skeptical mindset. However religious people may believe that the solution is a divine power that can guide you to the truth.


On the contrary, it is my conviction that this theory was created in order to promote the personal, and controversial beliefs of these thinkers. For example, famously, Plato believed that democracy should not exist and that it is simple-minded to have a system that puts intellectuals and common folk at the same level when it comes to voting. As with any controversy, there are some strengths to this argument such as are clear distinctions in people's education levels during 400 BC and especially as many don't even know what they're voting for. However, it is no surprise that this belief sparked major backlash and a long-lasting debate, that still goes on today. Moreover, if we look at Plato's logic here, we realize that he is making the distinction between those who are ignorant, and those who have seen the sun or taken the red pill, and is using it to promote his controversial beliefs opposing democracy, in order to get what he desires; power. Ultimately drawing parallels to both the allegory of the cave, as well as The Red Pill.

You may be thinking, how is this relevant today. This debate has been going on for years so why is it any more important now? Well, the answer is Andrew Tate: a name that creates an environment of hostility and animosity amongst young people as soon as it's mentioned. Yet riots in Romania, USA, Greece and many other nations have already arisen following his arrest on December 29th 2022. He uses metaphors from the 20TH century film to dispute any allegations against him by claiming, in his own words "The matrix has attacked me". Furthermore, he uses similar metaphors in order to support his extremist views. This is evident as he preaches feminism is but a trend, both created and normalized by the matrix and apparently that by 'taking the red pill' - like he claims to have done - you would see the flaws in feminism. Needless to say, this way of thinking is extremely dangerous as it means reducing people's experiences to mere illusion unless they follow your unique way of thinking; a method additionally used by religions, cults, and political leaders like Hitler and Stalin.

Finally, I would like to end with Nietzsche's view on solipsism and the belief that the world is not as it appears. In a book named 'Twighlight of the Idols' published in 1889, there is a chapter entitled 'How the True World Finally Became a Fable'. In this Nietzsche writes that if the real world outside the one we are living in is truly unknowable, then what is the point of even believing there is one as you will never be able to attain it, let alone even know if it exists. He states "The true world – an idea which is no longer good for anything, not even obligating – an idea which has become useless and superfluous. Constantly a refuted idea – Let us abolish it!" and so therefore the matrix, the cave, none of it has any point or real value to us. So even if it is the truth, we must let it die since this fixation is nothing but a futile hypothesis.
