








And the role each one of us can play in safeguarding children from harm.



The seminar was well-received by the attendees, with many expressing their commitment to promoting Thalassemia awareness within their own Rotary and Rotaract circles.











2ND INSTALLATION OF SEED BANK 30th Sep 2024 I DPS Vasant Kunj

We look forward to expanding this initiative further, making literacy accessible to more children and fostering a brighter future for the next generation.




