November is Rotary Foundation Month, a great time to get to know your Foundation better and pursue causes that appeal to you.




Diwali Celebration The GML also highlighted our spirited Diwali party, which brought members together in festive cheer, fostering fellowship and camaraderie within the Rotary family.

This symbolic event, showcasing unity and collaboration among Rotary clubs, has added to the pride of Rotary Club of Delhi Safdarjung.












4TH INSTALLATION OF HANGING LIBRARY & DISTRIBUTION OF NOTEBOOKS PROMOTING READING SKILLS






