#### **DIABETES CAMP (No. 18)**

Sugar-Free Life - A Story of Sweet Liberation.

Our weekly diabetes screening camp was successfully conducted on 18/11/24 at Darya Ram Hospital. We screened **63 individuals**. In total we have screened **1066 people in our eighteen camps** conducted till date.

#### **GESTATIONAL DIABETES**

Gestational Diabetes is a kind of diabetes that occurs during pregnancy. This kind of diabetes develops in pregnant women who have not previously had diabetes.

Gestational Diabetes is quite prevalent. This is why doctors screen for it during every pregnancy. While gestational diabetes can be a worrisome diagnosis, it is possible to have a healthy pregnancy and infant.

Myth: Gestational Diabetes only occurs in women with a history of Diabetes

**Fact:** Gestational diabetes can develop in any pregnant woman. However, there are certain factors that can increase the likelihood. These include:

**Family History:** Those with a strong family history of type 2 diabetes.

**Ethnicity:** Indian women are particularly at risk due to a genetic predisposition to insulin resistance and rising obesity rates.

Weight: Being overweight or obese prior to pregnancy can increase the risk.

**High-risk Pregnancies:** Factors like twin or multiple pregnancies, maternal age above 30 years, and history of fertility treatment can increase GDM risk.

**Previous Gestational Diabetes:** If a woman had gestational diabetes in a previous pregnancy, she's at a higher risk of developing it again.

Myth: After birth, Gestational Diabetes is permanently gone.

**Fact:** Although blood sugar levels usually return to normal after pregnancy, the complications of gestational diabetes can linger. Women who have had GDM are at high risk of getting type 2 diabetes during the next five years. In addition, there is a higher risk of gestational diabetes in future pregnancies, as well as obesity, fatty liver, and coronary artery disease. Monitoring and keeping a healthy lifestyle are critical even after pregnancy.


