remember our Past RI President Herbert J. Taylor who was so magnanimous that gift who transferred the rights of 4 Way Test to Rotary International. Since this is sacred like Bible to a Rotarian it becomes duty for the Rotarian to explain the relevance and importance of 4 Way Test to respect the same and tutor them to keep this with that respect. To once again remind our members and other 1.42 million Rotarian's around the world S below is the History of Rotary's 4 Way Test:

The Four-Way Test, was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy.

One of the world's most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics is The Four-Way Test, which was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor (who later served as RI president) when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy.

This 24-word test for employees to follow in their business and professional lives became the guide for sales, production, advertising, and all relations with dealers and customers, and the survival of the company is credited to this simple philosophy. Adopted by Rotary in 1943, The Four-Way Test has been translated into more than a hundred languages and published in thousands of ways.



CREATIVE THINKING

Once Late Sh. Ratan Tata was holding a weekly meeting with Tata Steel staff in Jamshedpur. A worker took up a serious issue. He said the quality and hygiene of toilets for the workers was very bad. Whereas, he pointed that the cleanliness and the hygiene of executive toilets was always very good. Ratan Tata asked his top executive how much time he needs to set it right. The executive asked for a month to set it right.

He said "I would rather do it in a day. Send me a carpenter." Next day, when the carpenter came, he just ordered the sign boards to be swapped. The sign board on the workers' toilet displayed "Executives" and the Executives' toilet displayed "Workers".

Ratan Tata then instructed this sign to be changed every fortnight. The quality of both the toilets came at par in the next three days. Leadership is something much more than being an Executive.

MORAL OF THE STORY:

Problem identification requires critical thinking, but solving a Problem just requires creative thinking. This is not just a story but a Leadership lesson as well.

प्लास्टक कचर स बचाएँ

प्लास्टिक समाज में वरदान से विनाश बन जाने का उत्कृष्ट उदाहरण है । एक बार चमत्कार साबित हुआ प्लास्टिक कई मायनों में प्रकृति के लिए खतरा बन गया है जो समुद्री जीवन से लेकर भूमि संसाधनों तक को प्रभावित करता है । एकल उपयोग प्लास्टिक जिसे अक्सर डिस्पोजेबल प्लास्टिक के रूप में जाना जाता है आमतौर पर प्लास्टिक पैकेजिंग के लिए उपयोग किया जाता है और इसमें ऐसी वस्तुएं शामिल होती हैं जिनका उपयोग फेकने या पुनर नवीनीकरण करने से पहले केवल एक बार किया जाता है । प्लास्टिक गैर बायोडिग्रेडेबल है और हमारे स्वास्थ्य, वन्य जीवन और पर्यावरण को नुकसान पहुंचाते हैं । प्लास्टिक के कचरे को विघटित होने में वर्षों लग जाते हैं और यह आगे चलकर प्लास्टिक के छोटे-छोटे टुकड़ों में बदल जाता है जिन्हें माइक्रो प्लास्टिक कहा जाता है । जो हमारे भोजन और जल संसाधनों को दूषित करता है इसलिए हम अपने भोजन और जल स्रोतों को नुकसान पहुंचाने के जोखिम में है जिससे मानव जीवन में कई जटिलताएं पैदा हो सकती हैं ।

भारत सरकार प्लास्टिक से पर्यावरण को होने वाले खतरे को कम करने के लिए रचनात्मक नीतियां लेकर आई है इसे तीन तरीकों से हासिल किया जा सकता है:

- 1. प्लास्टिक की खपत में कमी
- 2. प्लास्टिक का प्न: उपयोग एवं
- 3. प्लास्टिक की रीसाइकलिंग

पर्यावरण में इधर-उधर फैले प्लास्टिक के अधिकांश एकल उपयोग वाले प्लास्टिक जैसे प्लास्टिक प्लेट, चम्मच, गिलास, एकल उपयोग पॉलिथीन और दैनिक उपयोग से संबंधित अन्य प्लास्टिक है । एक रोटेरियन के रूप में हमारे लिए यह महत्वपूर्ण है कि हम अपने दैनिक जीवन में प्लास्टिक की खपत को कम करें ।

कई अन्य विकल्प सामग्रियां उपलब्ध है जिनका उपयोग प्लास्टिक के स्थान पर किया जा सकता है | यह हमारी जिम्मेदारी है कि हम अपनी धरती मां को बचाने के लिए समाज को खतरे के बारे में जागरूक करें | यह भी महत्वपूर्ण है कि यदि हम ऐसे प्लास्टिक का उपयोग करते हैं तो उन्हें पर्यावरण में भी नहीं फेंकना चाहिए | सभी प्लास्टिक कचरे को कूड़ेदान में फेंक दिया जाना चाहिए जहां से वह सरकारी एजेंसियों या निधि एजेंसियों के माध्यम से रीसाइकलिंग के लिए नियोजित भूमि क्षेत्र में जाएंगे | इससे यह सुनिश्चित होगा कि प्लास्टिक पर्यावरण में नहीं जाएगा और हम अपनी धरती मां की रक्षा करेंगे | इसलिए हम अपने गांव, शहरों के अपने साथी नागरिकों को इसे एक मानक अभ्यास के रूप में बनाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित कर सकते हैं | हम अपने स्कूली बच्चों, कॉलेज के छात्रों और विश्वविद्यालय को शिक्षित कर सकते हैं ताकि हम अपनी धरती मां और मानवता को इस अनदेखे खतरे से बचा सके |




