The following code of conduct has been adopted for the use of Rotarians: As a Rotarian, I will






Larry Lunsford Named President-Nominee for 2027-2028

Rotary Membership – A Journey of Growth & Impact

In August 2025, Rotary added 28,727 new Rotarians and 3,003 new Rotaractors, with the Rotaract movement seeing over 13,000 annual gains. Women's participation is increasing, enhancing the inclusiveness of Rotary. The call to action emphasizes building a stronger Rotary through individual contributions.



Each year on 24 October, Rotary and Rotaract clubs around the world Join with our partners, health organizations, and public health advocates to mark World Polio Day. We have a critical role in this by hosting events and activities to increase awareness about polio and raise funds toward eradicating it. To build on the success of last year, we needy our help. It's no secret that global health programs like the Global Polio Eradication Initiative are facing unprecedented funding challenges amid changing government priorities, rising rates of vaccine hesitancy, and the spread of misinformation. Rotary made a promise to the children of the world that no child should suffer the consequences of this vaccine-preventable disease.

Rotary International Award

The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International conferred the International PolioPlus Service Award to past Rotary International president Rajendra K Saboo. The Trustee Chairman of the Rotary Foundation Holger Knaack and his wife Suzanne, along with another Foundation Trustee Dr Bharat Pandya, brought the award and personally presented to him. Rajendra K. Saboo since the inception of the Rotary's efforts to eradicate polio from the world at a time in 1981 to 1983 when he was on the Board of Rotary International as one of the Directors.



He was instrumental in the initiation of the National Immunisation Day for nation-wide polio immunisation of children below 5 years, in the country, worked relentlessly in the transportation of the polio vaccine from abroad and maintenance of cold chain through Rotary volunteers who participated with the government health authorities in reaching out to the people pan India.

UNICEF and WHO express gratitude to the Rotary Foundation for approving \$50 million in grants to the Global Polio Eradication Initiative in June 2025. Funding will strengthen surveillance systems in Nigeria, support vaccination efforts for children under five in Afghanistan and Pakistan, and ensure rapid response to new outbreaks but we new your help.



globally. This investment aligns with Rotary's commitment to polio eradication, which is often matched by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to enhance impact, aiming to eliminate wild poliovirus from the last two endemic countries and prevent its resurgence.



TRF raised over US\$569 million in the 20224-25 year, facilitating support for global and local service projects. The Foundation surpassed US\$2.050 billion for its Endowment, enhancing long-term resources for impactful initiatives. In 2024-25, TRF awarded 1,424 global grants, 468 district grants, and 74 disaster response grants, renewed its agreement with the Gates Foundation to combat polio, awarded a Programs of Scale grant for peacebuilding in Colombia, and partnered to create a Rotary Peace Center in India. Doing Good in the World begins with individuals committed to service.







The visit of the District Governor to Vizianagaram on September 29, 2025, was a well-coordinated event, with members, along with AG Krishna Gopal and President Vijay Agarwal, warmly welcoming him upon arrival at 7 p.m. The following day began with a meeting involving key figures such as the President, Secretary, and President-Elect Rtn. Jagadish Godavarthi. A highlight of the visit was the inauguration of a Blood Donation camp, underscoring the district's commitment to community service. During a subsequent press meet, the District Governor outlined district goals, including initiatives like CPR training. Followed by Club Assembly, where he addressed and clarified members' questions. 
