Our Rotary District 3141 got initiated in 1929 with the formation of The Rotary Club of Bombay, Mumbai's first Rotary Club. Our District now has about 119 clubs with over 6,000 members and covers the geographical area from Churchgate to Dahanu & CST to Mulund.

The District is part of the **Zone 4 region of Rotary International** and has been among the **top 3** best performing Districts in the world in the last few years – it is recognized as a **Premier District in the Rotary World.**

The District is also a lead performer in the area of Service Projects – doing projects worth almost INR 300 Crores every year.
