NI-KSHAY MITRA and the Pradhan Mantri TB MUKT BHARAT ABHIYAN

Tuberculosis is a highly infectious disease caused by a bacterium. It is an airborne disease that spreads from one person to another through coughing, sneezing or talking. Not all infected persons contract the disease but good and balanced nutrition strengthens the immune system against Tuberculosis, under-nourishment leaves them susceptible.

Under The National TB Elimination Programme patients are supported with free diagnostics and medicines However, despite Government initiatives the goal of TB Mukt Bharat is well nigh impossible without community participation

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare thus introduced a scheme where the community is encouraged to adopt TB patients and support them in the form of Nutritional support , Nutritional supplements, additional investigations and vocational support for a minimum period of six months or a maximum period of three years . This Initiative was launched by the President on 9th September 2022.

KSHAY is Sanskrit for the term that defines the medical condition and NI-KSHAY MITRA very aptly describes a person who believes in providing nutritional support to the members of impoverished TB affected patients
