



As #RCHE proudly declares, we will continue this journey for years to come, because every child deserves a heart full of possibilities.







Where History Meets the Sea!

The year is 2024. A gentle breeze whispers secrets from the Arabian Sea, carrying the salty tang of the ocean and the echoes of a century past, caresses my face as I stand before the Majestic Gateway of India.

"Ah, yes, the irony!" I exclaimed. "This magnificent structure, built to commemorate their arrival, wasn't even complete then."


