Sweta's Simple quick homemade mouth watering Rasagullahs

The healthy SWEET


Yield: ~30 nos.

Ingredients:

- 2 Liters milk (skimmed also works)
- Half 1 fresh lemon juice / 1-3 Spoons of curd / 2-3 spoons of vinegar for curdling
- 1 spoon of unroasted rawa (semolina)
- Sugar (approximately 1 tbsp per rasgullah)
- 3-4 elaichi (cardamom) crushed

- 1. Boil Milk: Boil milk in a pot until hot and boiling well.
- 2. Curdling: Add half 1 fresh lemon juice / 1-3 Spoons of curd / 2-3 spoons of vinegar. Keep at low flame for few minutes until cottage cheese (chhena, home made paneer) separates fully from water.
- 3. Strain and Knead: Strain well, add 1 spoon of unroasted rawa, and knead until smooth.

 Make it smooth.
- 4. Rest: Keep aside for 10-15 minutes.
- 5. Make Balls: Make smooth round balls, 1.5-2 inches in diameter. Redo if there are cracks.
- 6. Pressure Cook: Take a pressure cooker, heat water, add sugar, and crushed elaichi. Add balls loosely, leaving space around for expansion.
- 7. Cook: Pressure cook for 10-12 minutes in medium flame.
- 8. Serve: Soft, sweet, delicious rasagullah is ready. Handle with care, as they will be very soft. Serve refrigerated or warm.

Tips:

- Use full cream milk for best results.
- Adjust sugar to taste.
- Handle rasagullah with care, as they will be soft and delicate.
- Serve immediately for best taste, or refrigerate/freeze for later use.
