Dear Fellow Rotarians, Partners and Friends,

- 01.07.23 :** Blood Donation Camp @ Churchgate Station. We were the lead Club along with 7 other Clubs. We collected 100 Bottles during the day.
- 05.07.23 :** BOD meet @ Dipan's Office, Fort. The Fees for the Year July 23-June 24 was discussed and fixed up @ Rs. 47000/- (Couple) and Rs. 37000(Single) was fixed up.
- 07.07.23 :** Club Assembly- The same was conducted in the presence of AG Sanjeev Kulkarni. 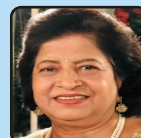
