Nalanda by Aditya Birla Education Trust also has strong support programmes of remediation, counselling and socio-emotional development of students. Co-curricular activities, events, inter-school competitions, field trips, guest lecturers and workshops make it an enjoyable experience for them.

The ANNUAL SPORTS DAY at Nalanda by Aditya Birla Education Trust was held on 6th December at Sassoon Ground. Pre-sports were conducted on three days; from 2nd December to 4th December 2024. Team events like tug-of-war, throw ball, cricket, football, carom, table-tennis and individual events like kick the ball, throw the ball, chess and skating were held during the pre-sports. Students tested their skills in a variety of indoor and outdoor sports.
