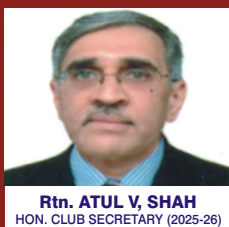
Let me break it down for you :

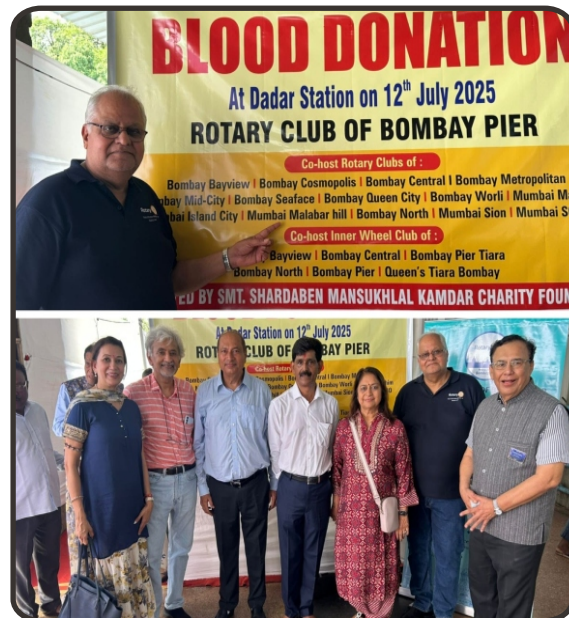

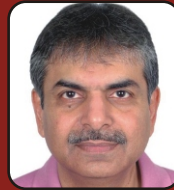
