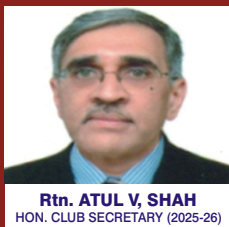
Together, We Serve

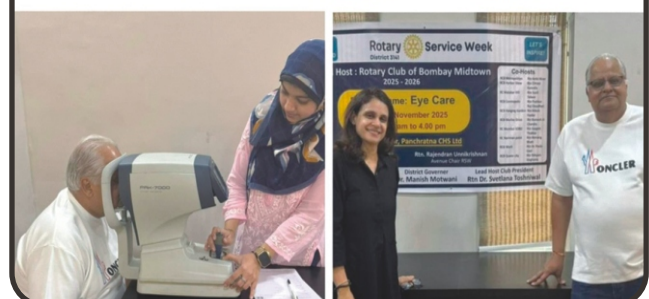
