Free Eye Check-up Camp

Free Eye Check-up Camp was organized at Central Shala, Solsumba on 14th September, 2025. The camp was conducted under the leadership of Rtn. Ashana Patel with the active support of fellow Rotarians and Anns.

The camp received a very good response with around 200 people attending for eye examinations. During the check-up, 35 patients were detected with cataract and other symptoms and were guided for further medical attention.

Free Eye Surgery



All surgeries, medical facilities, and transport arrangements were provided completely free of cost to the patients.

During the project, light snacks and fruits were also served to the patients to ensure their comfort.
