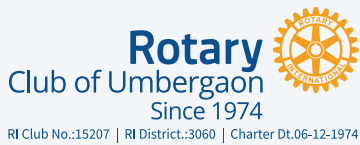

Upgradation & Inauguration of Rotary Physiotherapy Centre

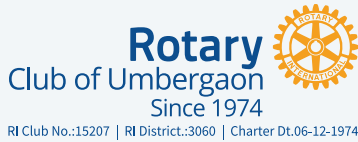

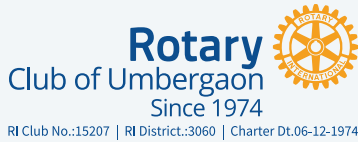
The event continued with the President-Secretary Meeting, followed by the BOD Meeting and General Meeting, where various club activities, achievements, and future plans were discussed.

ROH (Ray of Hope)

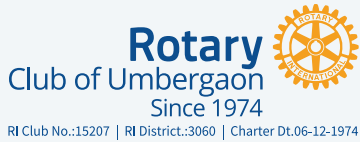

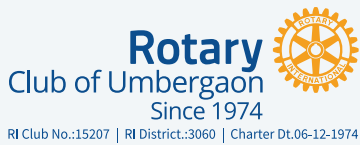
Under this project, 11 low-weight pregnant women were identified and benefited through the distribution of nutrition kits containing essential nutritional items required during pregnancy.

Donation of Wheel Chair

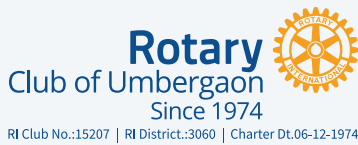

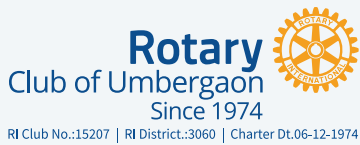

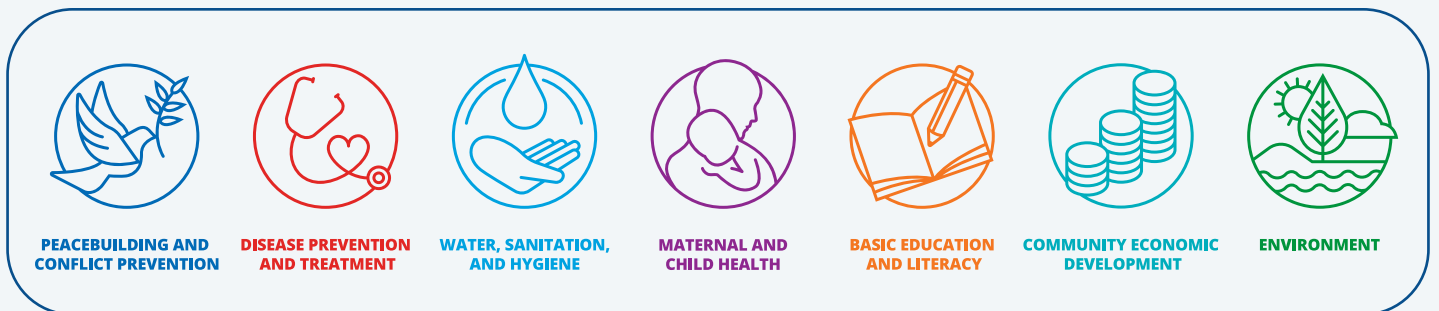
