

HUMF

This is one of our continuous projects. We give nutritious food kits to underweight and high-risk pregnant females. This way we are ensuring that the mother and her new born babies get enough nutrition food. Through local Anganwadi we assess the needy female and give food kit to them every month.



















Ray of Hope (ROH)

We initiated this project since last year. It is our initiative to treat malnourishment in children. We aim at eradicating Malnourishment in kids at our adopted village.















Extended Literacy

We look literacy in different light. This time we thought to spread Financial Literacy and Medical Literacy to females. Under this project we have organized speaker's meet where Dr. Pranav Parekh (MD DGO) took a lecture on Cosmetic & Regenerative Gynaecology & Mr. Gyanesh Shirsath (Relationship Manager - ICICI Prudential Mutual Fund) took lecture on Financial Management.





















Fighting Anemia

We previously conducted blood check-up camp in which 8 teenage girls were found having Haemoglobin level below 8% so we decided to give them a food kit which contains combination of iron & protein rich food. We will provide these kits for 3 months & then reassess their HB level.

LITERACY PROJECTS

Literacy is most important factor in development of any nation. Global literacy rate among adults has grown from 67% in 1976 to 87.01% in 2022. The degree of literacy in India was about 76.32% in men and around 59.3% in females in 2022. This gap is bit disturbing. Also Rural-Urban gap exists there.


