


It takes far reaching vision to see when people fall and a hand outstretched to help them again stand proud and tall It takes a shoulder to the wheel and words of "Let's begin!"


It takes a voice of hope— to be a Rotarian

August is Membership and New Clubs month





What is <u>#rotaryinternational</u>? It is a membership organization that does the world's best service. Why do we want to grow Rotary? To have more hands and hearts to do more good in the world through serving others. So how do we grow <u>#Rotary</u>?

For sustainable growth, we need to take a holistic approach, which involves three distinct strategies:

- 1.Attract new members and add them to our existing #rotaryclubs;
- 2. Retain members in our existing clubs, by engaging them in impactful service projects, both local and international; and
- 3. Form new clubs, for those who want to serve others in different ways than our current clubs do.

That's it - all we need to do! However, we need to employ all three strategies at the same time.

There is one other thing we need to keep in mind as we implement these strategies - the club experience/club culture. It affects all three stratagies. Club culture is the way a club operates. If things are going smoothly in a club, the club's culture is a source of strength. If things are not going smoothly, that club's culture likely needs shifting to realize a different result.

If a club's culture is good, it makes it easier for that club to attract new members and retain its existing members. If a club's culture is bad, its members will need to change the club's culture to increase its membership, or form a new/additional club with a culture that fits better with those who are not happy in the current club.





SOLAR IMPULSE



The Solar Impulse 2, a Swiss-engineered aircraft, made history by flying around the world using only solar power—no fuel, no emissions, and purely clean energy. Covering over 40,000 km, the mission began in 2015 and concluded in 2016, making 17 stops across 4 continents.

With a wingspan wider than a Boeing 747 but lighter than a car, it housed over 17,000 solar cells on its wings and fuselage. The aircraft could fly day and night, storing solar energy in onboard batteries for night time propulsion.

This mission wasn't about speed or convenience—it was a symbol of sustainable innovation. Solar Impulse 2 proved that renewable energy isn't a dream for the future—it can already carry us around the world.
