





# Cedar Rapids pilot to fly across Atlantic in support of polio eradication



A Cedar Rapids pilot is currently flying across the Atlantic Ocean to support polio eradication efforts with a goal of raising \$1 million for the cause. The campaign has already raised \$100,000.

Peter Teahen, of Cedar Rapids, is flying with his co-pilot Ed Galkin, of New Jersey. The pair's journey began Saturday, taking off from New Jersey. **The entire journey will take them 37 days with stops in 11 countries.** 

Teahen and Galkin are longtime Rotary Club members and are raising money through the Rotary Foundation. The Gates Foundation is matching donations, providing \$2 for every \$1 donated to the campaign.

Teahen joined the Cedar Rapids West Rotary Club in 1984, only a year before the Rotary Foundation started its polio eradication education efforts.

"On the international level, to see the energy that we created so just completely blows us away. And that's why we're so excited to do this trip, and why Rotarians are supporting us, saying this is the most unique fundraiser ever done," said Teahen.

## **Highlights of Board of Directors meeting held on September 3**



#### All the water in the world



If we were to put all the water on Earth into a single ball, we would be surprised at how small it is compared to the planet itself. Although water covers about 71% of the Earth's surface, giving it the appearance of a blue planet, the majority of this amount—about 97%—is found in the oceans and salty seas, unfit for drinking or direct use. The fresh water we need for life is extremely limited, with more than 2% of it locked away in ice caps and glaciers. Less than 1% is left for humans, distributed among rivers, lakes, and groundwater. This amount is the basis for all our agricultural, industrial, and other life activities.

If we were to imagine all this water combined, it would form a ball with a diameter of no more than 1,400 kilometers, a size that seems modest compared to the Earth's diameter of more than 12,700 kilometers. Even the deepest point in the ocean, the Mariana Trench, which is about 11 kilometers deep, remains extremely shallow compared to the Earth's enormous thickness of more than 6,370 kilometers.

This simple visualization reveals that water, despite its overwhelming presence on Earth's surface, is merely a thin, fragile layer surrounding a vast planet. It's an important reminder that freshwater resources are severely limited, and that their conservation and wise management have become an urgent necessity in the face of climate change and the ever-increasing human population.
