Rotary International President for 2026-27 Selected



Sang-Koo Yoon, former director of Rotary International of the Rotary Club of Saehanyang, Seoul, South Korea, was selected by a nominating committee on 5 March to be the 2026-27 Rotary International president-designate. If there are no other challengers, President-nominee Yoon Sang-koo will officially become president-elect on Sept. 15.

Yoon-nominee holds bachelor's and master's degrees in architecture from Syracuse University in New York and an honorary doctorate from the University of Edinburgh in Scotland. He is the founder and CEO of Dongseo Corporation, a building materials and engineering company, and the president of Youngan Co., Ltd., which operates real estate and financial investments. He also has a special interest in the preservation of cultural heritage and participates in many civic organizations.

He began his Rotary career in 1987 as a charter member of the Rotary Club of Saehanyang, and has served as a RI director, trustee, committee member and chair, and training leader. For eight years, he served as co-chair of the Make Mongolia Green project by Rotary members in Korea. His RI committee roles include the Board Administration Committee (2013-15, Vice-Chair 2014-15), the International Assembly Committee (Vice-Chair, 2020-21), and the End Pollio. Now Countdown Campaign Committee (Regional Chair, 2023-27). He also served on The Rotary Foundation's Executive Committee (2019-22, chaired by 2020-21) and on the Program Committee (2019-22, chaired by 2020-22).

He received The Rotary Foundation Special Achievement Award in 2021-22. He was awarded the Order of the British Empire (OBE) by Queen Elizabeth II of the United Kingdom and the Order of Friendship and Goodwill by the President of Mongolia. He was also awarded the Presidential Citation of the Republic of Korea and the Prime Minister's Commendation. He was honorably discharged as an engineer in the Republic of Korea Army and is an honorary elder of Andong Presbyterian Church.

Along with his spouse, Eunsun Yang, he is a Rotary Foundation Benefactor, Major Donor, Arch Klumph Society member, Paul Harris Society member, and Bequest Society. They have two children.


घर, समाज और मुल्क जिसके कंधे पर खड़ा है


