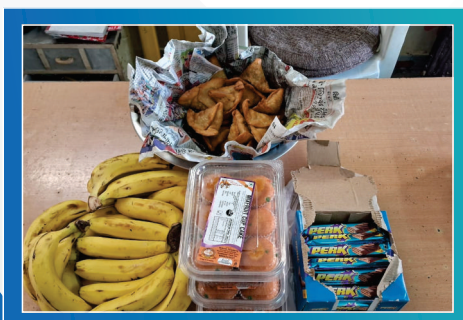
NURTURING FUTURES: HUMF'S SUPPORT FOR EXPECTANT MOTHERS

2.	Why "Rotary"?: The name comes from the practice of rotating meetings among members' offices.
3.	First Service Project: Rotary's first community service was installing public toilets in Chicago, emphasizing public welfare.
4.	The Rotary Wheel: The iconic logo is a gear wheel, representing work and movement, officially adopted in 1924.
5.	Polio Eradication: Since 1985, Rotary's PolioPlus program has contributed over \$2 billion to nearly eradicate polio worldwide.
