UNVEILING ENHANCED INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES AT AMALSADI SCHOOL

The Rotary Club of Surat conducted the handing over ceremony for a Global Grant project at **Uttar Buniyadi Vidyalaya in Amalsadi village near Palsana.** The project included the inauguration of a water station, classroom benches, a bathroom and toilet facility for the boys' hostel, a toilet block, and a computer lab. The ceremony was led by PDG Shrikant Indani, with **DG Tushar Shah** as the Chief Guest and **DGN Nilesh Shah** as the Special Guest. The event was also graced by the presence of **PDGs Himanshu Thacker and Hitesh Jariwala**, along with Past Presidents and members of the RC Surat.

Shri Prakashbhai Desai, President of the Bardoli Halpati Seva Sangh, welcomed the guests, followed by a welcome speech by President of the Rotary Club of Surat, Jai Mistry. **PP Dr. Ajay Mahajan** provided an overview of the project, followed by the ceremonial address by **PDG Shrikant** Indani and a speech by **Shri Manojbhai Desai**, Secretary of the Bardoli Halpati Seva Sangh, who expressed his appreciation.








TRANSFORMING LIVES: COMMUNITY HEALTHCARE THROUGH DIALYSIS

WHAT DOES NEW GENERATIONS MEAN?

New Generations refers to the youngest generation in the family of Rotary. Many are participants in Rotary's youth and young adult programs: Interact, Rotaract, Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA), and Rotary Youth Exchange. Others are servicemented young people involved in Rotary club and district activities.

Past RI President Luis Vicente Giay coined the term New Generations when he shared his belief that the future of Rotary relied on involving young people in the organization's programs and activities. At the 1996 RI Convention in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, he said:

"Our vision for the future, now more than ever, is the difference between success and failure. The New Generations are our investment in the future. Let us begin to build that future today."

New Generations Service became Rotary's fifth Avenue of Service in 2010. It is defined in article 5 of the Standard Rotary Club Constitution:

New Generations Service recognizes the positive change implemented by youth and young adults through leadership development activities, involvement in community and international service projects, and exchange programs that enrich and foster world peace and cultural understanding.

Rotary clubs should be committed to involving youth and young adults in their vocational, community, and international service projects, and to providing programs and resources that support them.


