GLOBAL HANDS, LOCAL HEALING ENDOSCOPY CENTRE HANDOVER AT NEW SHETH P.T. HOSPITAL


Rotary Club of Surat, formally handed over the Gastrointestinal Endoscopy Centre to New Sheth P.T. Multispeciality Hospital, Adajan, Surat, on Sunday, 11th May 2025, as part of its Global Grant Project (#2574796). This initiative was made possible through the contribution of international partner Rotary Club of Emory Druid Hills (USA) and the support of The Rotary Foundation, RID 3060, Rotary Club of Singapore, Madanben Babubhai Jariwala, and Bhavaniben Narendrakumar Mehta. The project reflects Rotary's commitment to improving access to essential healthcare through collaborative efforts.

The event was attended by members of the Rotary Club of Surat, representatives of the hospital trust, medical professionals, donor families, and invited guests, all of whom came together to mark the launch of this important service.

The programme began with the lighting of the lamp and a prayer led by **Prof. Ratna Jadhavani**, setting a peaceful tone for the morning.

Rtn. Jay Mistry, President of Rotary Club of Surat, gave the welcome address, thanking all global grant partners and emphasising Rotary's focus on sustainable healthcare initiatives. Mr. Sunil Modi, President of the Hospital Trust, welcomed guests on behalf of the hospital and appreciated Rotary's contribution to enhancing the facility. Rtn. Yatish Parekh, representing the hospital trust, shared the background and journey of the hospital's community work.









PP Nikhil Madrasi introduced and acknowledged the presence of all supporters and partners. Primary Contact **PP Dr. Ajay Mahajan** presented a summary of the project and its impact as part of Rotary's ongoing service efforts. **Dr. Madhukar Parikh**, representing the hospital, spoke about the institution's healthcare services for the community.
