Professionally, he is the driving force behind two ventures: Micro Systems (Ankleshwar) and Microcontrols International FZE (Dubai), with over 25 years in process control and automation. His excellence has been recognised globally by ABB, earning him top honours like the Asia Pacific Best Performance Award (2013) and the Global Best Performance Award (2021).

In Rotary, he is known for his visionary spirit and impactful service. A committed member of the Rotary Club of Bharuch, he exemplifies Rotary's core values through both action and contribution. He is a Major Donor – Level 2, a proud Paul Harris Society Member, a Polio Plus Society Member, and a Benefactor to The Rotary Foundation, reflecting his deep-rooted dedication to Rotary's mission of service above self.

He was recognised as the Best New Rotarian in 2007–08, followed by the Best Project Chairman in 2012–13.
