

Today, the club is a revered entity in District 3060, with a rich history and a bright future, symbolizing the power of community service and embodying the principles of Rotary International. Since its inception in 1937, the Rotary Club of Surat has made significant contributions to the well-being and development of its community, embodying the principles of Rotary International.





This act exemplifies Rotary Club's unwavering commitment to uplift these young souls in the best possible ways, offering the youngest members of our community a chance at brighter future.


