LET'S HAVE A GLANCE OF IT!!

Here's a summary of some of the key projects and initiatives undertaken by the Rotary Club of Surat:

- 1. In the village of Niyol, located near Surat, the Rotary Club provided water facilities to the entire village. It was an era when infrastructure facilities were not easily available, they ensured that the village had access to potable drinking water with the installation of RO water tank and underground pipelines.
- 2. In the Umra Cremation Ground, a solar plant and a water heater plant were established with the help of generous sponsorship and contribution of Rotarians late Shri. Narendrabhai Mehta and Bhavaniben Mehta, serving as eco-friendly and sustainable energy sources.
- 3. A modern peace garden was developed at Veer Narmad South Gujarat University with the support of Rotarian. Late Shri. Narendrabhai Mehta and Bhavaniben Mehta.

These projects represent the Rotary Club of Surat's dedication to improving the quality of life in the region, providing essential services, and enhancing community infrastructure.

- 1. At the Guru Nanak Dharmarth Hospital located on Bhatar Road Surat, the Rotary Club of Surat has installed 7 dialysis machines at the Dialysis Centre.
- 2. The Rotary Club of Surat has established the Rotary Aswin Mehta Memorial Planetarium, which is currently in a closed state. This planetarium used to provide educational knowledge to the public. However, the knowledge and educational activities that took place in this planetarium are now being conducted at the Science Centre managed by the Surat Municipal Corporation.
- 3. Located near Kim, hospitals such as Sadhana Hospital, Lokhat Hospital, Surat Diamond Hospital, and Sanjeevani Hospital have received donations of dialysis machines and ventilator machines.

These initiatives by the Rotary Club of Surat demonstrate their commitment to improving educational and healthcare facilities, providing essential medical equipment in the region.

- 1. At the Vankawala Children's Hospital in Majuragate, Surat, various medical equipment was provided.
- 2. A Women Empowerment Centre was initiated in Chhapara-bhatha, sponsored by Rotarian Babubhai Jariwala.
- 3. In the primary school of Ponsara, Club have provided a toilet block, an R.O. plant, a hand wash station, school benches, greenboards, and shoes, sweaters, and raincoats for the students.
- 4. The primary school in the northern part of the Amalsadi village near Palsana, which has been adopted by the Rotary Club of Surat, is currently undergoing renovation at a cost of 70 lakh rupees through a global grant.
- 5. The club has adopted Uttar Bunyadi School, Amalsad in Palsana district, identified to carry out substantial renovations in the school, amounting to around 70 lakhs rupees through a global grant to create an enable learning environment for students.

The Rotary Club of Surat has also made significant contributions to the Rotary Foundation.

As of now, the Rotary Club of Surat has donated 6,03,627 US dollars to The Rotary Foundation - TRF, which is approximately equivalent to 5,01,01,041 rupees (5 crores, 1 lakh, and 1,041 rupees). The club achieved the title of "Major Donor" - Paul Harris Club banner by donating around 10,000 US dollars, which is roughly equal to 8,30,000 rupees, on June 24, 2021. (1\$ equivalent to Rs. 83).


