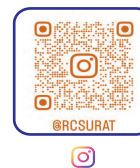

Rotary Club of Surat marked a proud milestone with the formal handover of a **Laparoscopy Unit to METAS Adventist Hospital, Athwalines, Surat**, under **Global Grant #2686283 of The Rotary Foundation**. The gathering included distinguished Rotary leaders **DG Amardeep Singh Bunet, DGE Nilesh Shah, DGN Ashish Patwari, DGND Vipul Patel, IPDG Tushar Shah, PDG Himanshu Thackar, PDG Hitesh Jariwala and PDG Santosh Pradhan, AG Kshitij Desai**, district officers and members of RC Surat.

The programme began with a **welcome address by Dr. Mohan Rao, Vice President of METAS Adventist Hospital**, followed by a brief overview of the hospital shared by **Ms. Pratima Deepak**.

President of RC Surat, Kundan Shah, addressed the gathering and highlighted Rotary's continued commitment to strengthening healthcare services in the community. 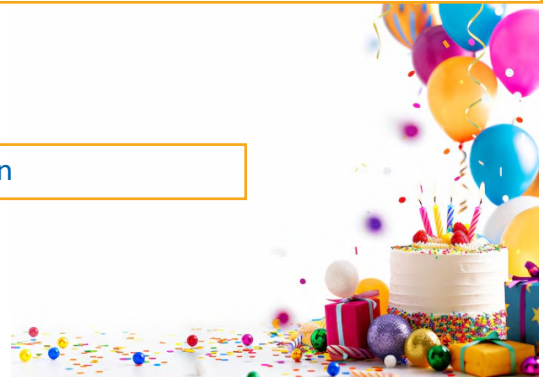
