ELECTION SEASON – THE NOISE, THE CHOICE, AND THE FOUR QUESTIONS

With local body **elections** underway across Gujarat, the air crackles with conversations. Every chai stall has become a parliament. Every family dinner, a debate. Opinions fly fast. Allegiances are declared. And in the middle of all this **noise**, one thing becomes clear: every **voice matters**. Every single **vote**? It's a brick in the future we are building together.

But here's the thing about a lively democracy—**passion** can easily tip over into prejudice. Arguments can turn into accusations. And in that heat, we often forget what matters most. That's where a simple, almost old-fashioned, **compass** comes in. **Just four questions**. But they can cut through any political clutter like nothing else. Before you share that **viral forward**, before you shut down a neighbour, before you cast your vote—ask yourself:

- **Is it the truth?** Or just a convenient half-truth wrapped in anger?
- **Is it fair to all concerned?** Not just to “my side,” but to everyone this decision touches?
- **Will it build goodwill and better friendships?** Or will it burn a bridge you might need tomorrow?
- **Will it be beneficial to all concerned?** Not just your party, your caste, or your pocket—but the wider **we**?

Elections are, by design, a clash of ideas. They are meant to be **noisy**. But they don't have to be **ugly**. This year, Let's not just vote. Let's **pause**, let's **listen**, and let's use these **four questions as a filter**—for our words, our shares, and our choices.

Choose wisely. Act responsibly.
Keep the **Four-Way Test** closer than party symbol.
That's not simple. That's **powerful**.
