The city that improves the morning of the countrymen by providing pure milk to the entire country through Amul is Anand and we will know a little about the life of Rtn. Nihir Dave who is known as Milky Man of Anand.

Who does not know Rotary, an international social organization?

As smart as Nihirbhai looks, he is now leader for the year 2023-24 for the organization that has done the groundwork for the eradication of polio worldwide and will be the backbone of

more than 115 units of the Rotary organization. The smart things he has done in the small village of Anand and have provided a true example of human service.

Moving more than 115 clubs together towards a certain goal is not an easy task. It requires many qualities like sharp intelligence, eloquence, foresight, teamwork. Nihirbhai has it all and that is why all the Rotary Clubs from Umargam to Mahemdabad, entire Saurashtra and from Nandurbar to Dhulia of Maharashtra have chosen Nihirbhai as their leader.

When a person is chosen as the leader of a social organization, it is naturally expected that he will continue to achieve professional success, this is clear to us when we look at his professional career.

He is a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil). He specializes in valuation and related advisory. He is a Chartered Engineer and has further specialized in Land and Building Valuation. During the period of Covid, he actively contributed to the LN 4 project which gifted artificial hands to the needy, besides providing services of vaccinations, X-ray machines and oxygen concentrators. Apart from mammography and cancer detection camps, HUMF - Humanitarian Aid to Under privileged Maternity Wards Females and Niramaya Project are his prominent contributions.

His organization has also gifted 5 dialysis machines and 1 mobile medical van to the society with the global grant received by the Rotary Foundation from the international level.

Any successful person can be successful when his whole family stands by him. His wife Vaishaliben Dave is also a member of Rotary and past president of Innerwheel Club of Anand Round Town. In the year 2015-16, he received the award of one of the top five best spouses in Rotary. His son Shubham is the Vice President of Rotary's youth organization Rotaract Club of Anand Round Town, who participated in Rotary's 1-year international youth exchange program in Germany in 2017-18 to learn about the culture there. His daughter Vaibhavi is a practicing architect and is currently living in Mumbai gaining professional life experience in a multinational company.
