

In conversation with Rtn. Mihir Modi, District Co-ordinator - Club Extension (Saurashtra) - The man behind the formation of new Rotary Club "Prime" along with District Public Image Chair Rtn. Bhavesh Vegda.

Q. When did this all start?

Mihir : Rajkot has population of more than 18 Lacs and total number of Rotarians is merely touching 450 in 4 clubs. Since most of the clubs have reached their maximum capacity of

Avoidable Blindness Chairman - District(3060) Rtn. Dr. Ketan Bavishi managing members, it was necessary to start a new club for last 7-8 years. Rajkot being hub of social work and known in RI for its exceptional projects, it was needed that we can connect more and more people to Rotary and its ideology.

In first week of July, I got a call from District Membership Chair Rtn. Amardeepsingh Bunet in con-call with DG Prashant Jani, They said I have to take the responsibility of District Co-ordinator - Club Extension for Saurashtra region and gave me a target to form a club at different locations including Rajkot.

The first thing that I thought was that I am a Rotarian from RCRG which has a legacy of envisioning and executing landmarks and exceptional projects. This needs to be another such legacy.

Q. What is so special about this club?



Mihir : When I started working on RCRP, I did some research how the clubs are formed previously in Rajkot and in our District. Upon that I decided that my first agenda for this club will be a Greenfield club with no Split-Rotarians or ex-Rotarians or a ready-made group of people. Everyone will be handpicked purely based on the merit and reputation. I am lucky that I was able to find 52 such Charter Members from diverse fields but with same agenda of doing something for the society.

Second agenda was that to have atleast 10% female Rotarians and to that we have 6 female Rotarians out of 52 which is roughly 12% and we have 3 female Rotarians in Charter Committee which is a history in itself.

This was all because of the support of DPIC **Rtn. Bhavesh Vegda and Rtn. Kalpit Sanghavi** who supported me when I was surrounded with negativity and brought the hope by standing by my side without ego, without vested interest and helped me during the process. I remember how funnily Amardeepbhai used to say **"Modi hai to Mumkin Hai"** to motivate me.

This fifth club sponsored by **Rotary Club of Rajkot Greater** will act as a thumb to complete the Fist of Power to serve the humanity in Rajkot along with 4 other clubs.

Q. What difficulties did you face?

Mihir : I was wondering why my previous fellow Rotarians did not start the New Club and why there was no success in starting the New Club in Rajkot for the last 5-6 years. When I took the responsibility I came to know why. I came across lot of pressure, lot of negative motivation and lot of warnings. I was once even told that I will never be successful if I don't take help of a ready-made group but I was firm that if there will be a new club in Rajkot it will be a Greenfield club and I wanted new set of Rotarians who will be young, enthusiastic, and dynamic.

The most difficult part was to explain why one needs to join Rotary. I literally have to speak about the history of Rotary, its working methodology, club's culture, projects, fun & fellowship activites, and Rotarian's roles & responsibilities almost 5-6 times a day for at least one and half month. Sometimes I had to literally ask for the help of senior Rotarians regarding the questions that I was asked by the new members. I must say this new lot is very intelligent, straight forward, resourceful and of high emotional quotient.

Q. Where do you see this club in next 5 years?

Mihir : Seeing the enthusiasm and dynamism of members, I think in 2-3 years' time they will be able to have their own permanent project and one mega project. I wish they incorporate all the best qualities of all the clubs in Rajkot and have their own USP at District. I think this club has potential to give a DG in future.

Q. Do you have any special mentions?

Mihir : This process would not be possible without the help of our very own **Bhaveshbhai Vegda**. He stood by me as a rock, always there for any silly or serious issues that I faced and encouraged me that I can do this. Biggest thanks to him for accepting to become GSR for this new club. I owe him a lot. I know he will mentor this club to become another Greater or we should say the PRIME as the name suggests.

Thanks to **President Mehulbhai & Secretary Nileshbhai** for sponsoring and assuring to support the new club in its formative years.

At this juncture I miss my Guru my Bhaiji **Late Rajenbhai Modi** the charter member of RCRG. If he would have been alive today, he would be very proud of me. Though my father Upen Modi who was President of Rotract Club in his days, I was introduced to Rotary by Bhaiji. I miss you Bhaiji, I dedicate this one to you.

Special thanks to **DMC Amardeep Singh Bunet** and **DG Prashant Jani** for believing in me and giving this opportunity.

At last I wish all the 4 Rotary clubs support and nurture RCRP to become a tree of social initiatives.
