BEFORE THE COFFEE GETS COLD

Time travel and cafe culture yeild a lovely sentiment brew in a translation of Japanese author **Toshikazu Kavaguchi**'s popular play-turned novel - Before the coffee gets cold.

The speaker of this book-talk **Mr.Harsh Thaker**, in his simple yet effective tone took the audience in their respective past by his mesmerizing narration of the book. He made the audience feel very relatable even if they have not experienced similar circumstances as the characters of the novel. As a movie has also been produced from this novel, Harsh pointed out very minutely the difference and similarity between the two.





The book is divided in four parts and each story has its own emotional twist. The story is set in a cafe which allows its guests to travel in the past to visit any person they wish to have conversation with. Here, time travel is just a plot device and not a science fiction. It's much closer to 'magical realism'.

The important takeaway message that this book conveys is about **accepting your past** and make the **best of the future** while taking present as it comes without any change in it. The narratives are very nicely put together to produce a tale of love, hope, loss and fear that is sure to shake your emotional state.

Harsh finishes his talk by asking the audience a question that if you could go back in time, would you go and what would you say and whom would you like to meet? It was a very thought-provoking question. In short, it was very gentle, reflective, and gripping book talk.


