FROM PRESIDENT'S DESK

The month of August began with a strong focus on learning and inspiration. On 1st August, the District Learning Assembly for Interactors was held, where office bearers of our three Interact Clubs—Dadar Vidya Mandir, Chhatrapati Shivaji Vidyalaya, and Matunga Premier School—participated. Eminent district leaders, along with our District Governor, guided the students and highlighted the significance of being part of the Interact movement.



August was also marked by impactful service and vocational initiatives by RCMM:

- ➤ Donation of a **jigsaw machine** to Mumbai Public School, Ghatkopar, encouraging children to develop carpentry skills and become vocationally self-reliant.
- ➤ Donation of a **smart cane** to Sonu, a visually impaired student from Samvedana Foundation, enabling him to move independently and confidently.
- ➤ Provision of **nutritional kits to 10 TB patients**, food support to patient's families, from KEM and Tata Hospitals.
- ➤ Distribution of the **Ideal Study App** to Std. X students and teachers of Shishuvihar School, Dadar, and New English School, Khavati, Khed, to strengthen their academic preparation.

On 7th August, we hosted an engaging speaker meet where Rtn. Faisal Shaikh spoke on "Kaizen – A Way of Life." He explained the five principles—Sort, Set, Shine, Standardize, and Sustain—emphasizing that true change requires respect for people, resources, and the environment. His interactive style made the session both thought-provoking and memorable.

On 12th August, the **Installation Ceremony of Rotaract Club of Ramnarain Ruia College** was held at their college auditorium, where President Kasturi Kuthale and her team for 2025–26 took charge.

Further, as part of the **District Project Annapurna – Food for All**, RCMM distributed **180 packets of Oreo Choco Cream biscuits** to students of Seva Bharati Balwadi (52 children), Prabodhankar Thackeray School, Sewri (86 children), and Mira Vidyalaya, King Circle (42 children). This initiative was in collaboration with the Indian Humanity Foundation, supporting children with adequate nutrition.

CARPENTRY SKILL SUPPORT TO MUMBAI PUBLIC SCHOOL

On 6th August 2025, RCMM donated a Jigsaw Machine (Model No. J/819-24) to Mumbai Public School, Sainath Nagar, Ghatkopar, to enhance carpentry training for students. Notably, both boys and girls in the school are enthusiastic about learning the craft. During the event, the teacher demonstrated the machine's capabilities by skillfully creating a wooden cutout of Rtn. Dr. Darekar.

Mumbai Public School, Sainath Nagar is a BMC-run school with good infrastructure and dedicated teachers. Students are from the surrounding slum areas. The school offers vocational skills such as stitching, carpentry, and electrical work. Carpentry and electrical classes are conducted by Mr. Vilas Yewale, who has been training students for many years. He shared that with modern tools, these students could turn their skills into a livelihood, and requested for a a Jigsaw Machine to enhance their learning.

Providing such vocational training to underprivileged students not only builds their confidence but also equips them with skills that can help them earn a living and tackle unemployment in the community.













SAARTHI SMART CANE TO SONU BEBANSHI

Samvedana Foundation recommended supporting 22-year-old visually impaired student, Sonu Bebanshi. While AI glasses were considered, they require a smartphone. Instead, a Saarthi Smart Cane was chosen, as it would enable him to navigate safely and travel with confidence by detecting obstacles in his path. Saarthi is a smart mobility aid designed to detect obstacles in real-time, providing users with instant feedback through tactile vibrations.

On 6th August, 2025 PR Shaila along with Rtns. Lalit and Uma visited Samvedana Foundation at Kannamwar Nagar, Vikhroli, and donated the Saarthi Smart Cane to Sonu. His joy and gratitude were evident as he received it. A heartfelt thanks to Rtn. Uma Sahasrabudhe for generously funding this project.

RTN. FAISAL SHAIKH ON KAIZEN - A WAY OF LIFE

At our 7th August, 2025 RCMM meeting, we were treated to an engaging and thought-provoking session by Rtn. Faisal Shaikh on the Japanese philosophy of Kaizen - the art of continual improvement.

He opened with two striking images: one of a water gutter in Japan, clean enough for fish to swim in, and another of schoolchildren in uniform, picking up trash from the roadside on their way home. These, he explained, were not random snapshots, but reflections of Japan's culture - where cleanliness, discipline, and civic sense are ingrained from childhood. The habit of doing small good deeds daily has contributed greatly to Japan's progress, even after the devastation of the Hiroshima bombing. Instead of retaliation, Japan chose to compete with the world through excellence, becoming a leader in fields like automobile manufacturing and exporting some of the best cars to countries like the USA.

Rtn. Faisal introduced the 55 principle from Japan: Sort, Set, Shine, Standardize, and Sustain. By following these steps consistently, one can improve life in small, steady increments – the essence of Kaizen. "Kai" means change, and "Zen" means good – together, they mean change for the better.













RTN. FAISAL SHAIKH ON KAIZEN - A WAY OF LIFE

With relatable examples, he explained how meticulous habits bring lasting results. For instance, we often prefer buying second-hand cars from Parsis because they are well-maintained, regularly cleaned, and checked - unlike many of us who clean our homes only for Diwali, hoping Goddess Lakshmi will visit. Instead, he suggested, cleanliness and upkeep should be a daily practice, not a seasonal one.

The session was highly interactive. At one point, Rtn. Faisal made members play a fun game to test how well we knew each other, keeping everyone engaged and entertained. He also touched on Japanese manners, where bowing is a gesture of respect. In a light moment, our President bowed before felicitating him with a gift, and Usha, also bowed too while delivering the vote of thanks.

Overall, it was an inspiring and lively session – a reminder that meaningful change starts with small, consistent steps, and that Kaizen is not just a management tool, but truly a way of life.

IDEAL STUDY APP DISTRIBUTION AT SHISHUVIHAR MADHYAMIK VIDYALAYA





It proved to be a valuable learning experience for our young Interactors. PR. Shaila Rege and Rtn. Jayanti were also present to support and encourage the participants.


















