OFFICIAL CLUB VISIT - OCV

The Official Club Visit (OCV) of District Governor (DG) is the most important meeting in the President's tenure, aimed at scrutiny of various projects/activities of the club and records as well as accounts maintained at the club by the District.

OCV was held on 6th January, 2024 at Citylight Hall, Mahim. Prior to OCV, Pre OCV was held on 12th December, 2023 which was attended by AG Rtn. Rohan Dalmia to assess the preparation of the club for OCV. He expressed great satisfaction on the working of the club and fulfillment of the requirements of OCV. Hard copy of OCV Report was provided only to DG and soft copy was sent to others prior to the meeting.

The closed door meeting was held with 3 RCMM officials, DG Arun Bhargava and DS Sandip Kedia, AG Rohan Dalmia, TRF Head Prakash Ruia. DG Arun Bhargava perused the report on the funds budgeted and utilized on the projects. CSR certificate, Copy of Trust Deed, List of FDRs and suggested for converting Club By Laws in a brief form as per the new MOP.




Annadan at The Bombay Vigilance Association Balikashram




MEDICAL CAMP AT DADAR VIDYA MANDIR



1. Diabetes, Glacoma and Blood Pressure Screening Camp (Lead Club - RC Mumbai South)

RCMM co-hosted Diabetes, Glacoma and Blood Pressure Screening Camp held on 20th January, 2024 at the Mehta International Eye Institute. For the first time in District 3141, Computer based Optical Coherence Tomography was used to evaluate the central macular area of the retina, which is affected in diabetic and in blood pressure patients leading to fall in vision. With help of a new proprietary Al software, patients were able to get a time scan as to future problems with their eyes.




