



FROM PRESIDENT'S DESK



A very Happy New Year to all my Rotarian family members.

New year commenced with the Rotary Club of Mumbai Mahim organizing Inspire ROTAL, a three-day event. It was inaugurated on 4th January 2026 at Veer Savarkar Auditorium by District Governor Dr. Manish Motwani. Rehearsals were organized for 56 singing participants shortlisted for the finals. The grand finale, featuring singing and dancing performances was held on 11th January 2026, with winners felicitated with trophies and medals. The dedicated efforts and seamless execution by the ROTAL team were highly appreciated by all.

In support of Divyang children, RCMM donated a colour printer to Meera Vidyalaya, which will be used to create visual learning aids and support the children's educational and developmental needs.

A three-day Carrom Doubles Tournament for senior citizens was held at Shivaji Park, with 115 enthusiastic participants. Winners were honoured with trophies, making the event engaging and joyful.

As part of a District Project – Maha Aarogya Shivir held at Andheri, RCMM donated four wheelchairs and 100 spectacles to needy beneficiaries, contributing towards improved mobility and vision care.

Continuing its regular humanitarian support, ration kits were distributed to 10 TB patients, a project that RCMM carries out every month with commitment and compassion.

Under the Masik Chakra Project, an awareness session on menstrual hygiene was conducted for 325 Class VII girls at Cannosa High School, Mahim. The interactive session focused on myth-busting, awareness, and healthy menstrual practices, followed by the distribution of sanitary kits.

In a meaningful initiative to support children undergoing cancer treatment, 10 Lenovo tablets were donated to paediatric cancer patients residing at Kharghar. These tablets will help the children stay connected with their studies while receiving treatment in Mumbai.

Overall, the month was marked by impactful projects, community service, and heartfelt efforts towards making a positive difference in society.



The Rotary Club of Mumbai Mahim, in association with the Live Beyond Life Foundation, arranged an Organ Donation Awareness Program on 26th January 2026 at 9.30 am. Rtn. Sunita Padwal was invited as a speaker.

Riddhi Gardens CHS, Malad East, organizes a flag hoisting program every year, followed by a get-together. This year, Secretary Mr. Prabhat Billore decided to do something different and introduced an awareness session on organ donation—a cause very close to his heart. His aim is to register at least 1,000 organ pledge forms this year.

The session was an interactive talk with a group of 50+ society members. While many participants were aware of blood, kidney, and eye donation, very few knew about skin donation. The entire process of organ donation was explained in detail. The importance of pledging for organ donation and the consent of family members for successful execution after death was discussed at length, emphasizing the need to avoid denial of consent at the crucial time. There was active participation, and many doubts were clarified during the interaction.



St. Jude India Child Care Centre at ACTREC, Navi Mumbai, provides a 12-storey "home away from home" for children up to 15 years of age who are undergoing cancer treatment. The centre offers 234 residential units with free, hygienic accommodation, nutritious meals, transportation, and counselling services. Each year, it supports over 700 families, helping reduce treatment abandonment and promoting holistic care for long-term recovery.

On 28th January 2026, 10 Lenovo tablets were donated to the paediatric cancer patients at the St. Jude Centre, ACTREC. These tablets will enable the children to stay connected with their studies while receiving treatment in Mumbai. The centre itself was inaugurated in November 2025.

After the speaker session, dinner was served, giving members ample opportunity to mingle freely. The venue and food were excellent, and everyone thoroughly enjoyed the fellowship.





5. B1 - PDG Jyotindra Vakil Best Bulletin Shield for clubs having more than 50 members.


