Another meaningful initiative this month focused on women empowerment. This project was executed in the rural village of Warad in Konkan, Maharashtra, where 27 women farmers were provided with essential farming tools such as water pumps, hose pipes, and spray pumps. These tools will significantly reduce their manual labor, save time and energy, and ultimately enhance their productivity.

A special note of appreciation to Rtn. Varsha for securing CSR support from NRB Bearings, and to Rtn. Hemal for conceptualizing the project and managing its execution with such dedication. The villagers welcomed us warmly, and the distribution ceremony was filled with gratitude and high regard—a truly humbling experience.

This month's weekly meeting also received an excellent response, as we hosted an insightful lecture on "Spotting Early Signs of Dementia" and "Brain Aging, Cognitive Impairment, and the Caregiver Perspective."

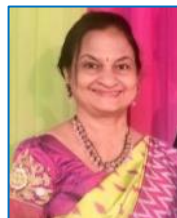

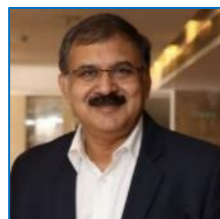

RATION DISTRIBUTION UNDER PRADHAN MANTRI TB MUKT BHARAT ABHIYAN

In continuation from last month, on 6th May, 2025 ration was distributed to 16 patients at BMC dispensary, behind Goa Portuguesa restaurant, City light. Rtns. Asavari and Dr. Gurmit distributed the ration personally. We will be providing the ration during the period of their medication. Hope this helps the patients to regain their health and lead the normal life.





EMPOWERING WOMEN FARMERS

The Rotary Club of Mumbai Mahim, in collaboration with NRB Bearings Limited, undertook a meaningful project to support and empower women farmers in the remote village of Warad Taluka Malvan, District Sindhudurg. Here, women traditionally engage in "Porasu" farming—cultivating small plots of land (2–4 gunthas) around their homes post-monsoon. These plots yield a mix of vegetables such as chilies, beans, corn, eggplants, and leafy greens, sustaining the families and generating modest income through local market sales.

Recognizing their efforts and the potential to enhance productivity, RCMM and NRB Bearings provided vital agricultural tools including electric pumps, petrol/diesel engines, spray pumps, and HDPE pipes on 6th May, 2025. A total of 27 women farmers received this support, enabling better irrigation and crop management.

'पोरसु' म्हणजे पावसानंतर काही मुळे जमिनीमध्ये शेती केली जाते. ही शेती प्रामुख्याने महिला मोठ्या प्रमाणात करतात. त्या महिला कुटुंबातील लोकंना पुरून ये उरले ते गावातील काजारात विकून काही पैसे मिळवितात. यामध्ये निरबी, पाती, खडी, मकर, झेंडू, मुळा, लाल भाजी,

HAPPY FEET – SHOE DISTRIBUTION DRIVE

The Rotary Club of Mumbai Mahim (RCMM), in collaboration with Yuva Foundation, proudly carried out the Happy Feet – Shoe Distribution Drive under the Bare Feet Project to bring comfort, dignity, and smiles to underprivileged children.

On 9th May, 2025, Yuva Foundation volunteers reached out to children living in the slum areas of Bandra and Mankurd, distributing sports shoes to those identified by the Yuva Foundation. For many of these children, it was the first pair of proper shoes they had ever owned — a small gesture that made a world of difference. The drive also extended support to children undergoing boxing training, who often have to manage without basic sports gear. Their coach, Mr. Rajan Jothady, expressed heartfelt gratitude, highlighting how essential proper footwear is for both performance and safety in the sport.

The effort continued on 12th May, 2025 at Savarkar Smarak, Shivaji Park, where RCMM distributed sports shoes to another group of underprivileged young boxers. Their dedicated coach, who trains them free of cost, shared that many of these aspiring athletes come from extremely modest backgrounds and are unable to afford even basic training essentials. As boxing requires compulsory footwear, this thoughtful donation is sure to enhance their training experience and morale.

This project was a perfect blend of compassion and impact — promoting health, sports, and self-esteem, one step at a time. A total of 118 children benefited from this thoughtful initiative.

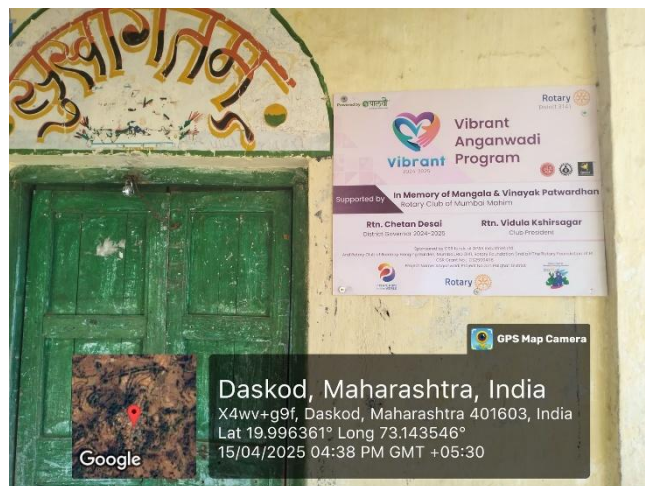
1. Vibrant Anaganwadi

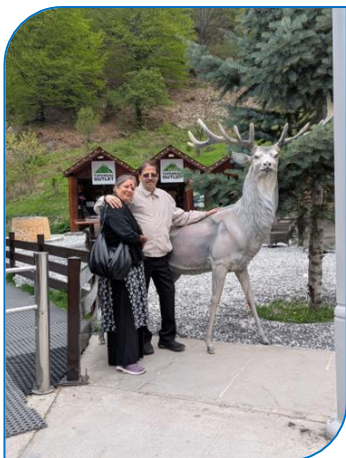

RECOGNIZING AND MANAGING DEMENTIA

Dementia is more than just memory loss—it affects a person’s thinking, behavior, and ability to perform everyday activities. To spread awareness and encourage early intervention, Rotary Club of Mumbai Mahim organized an insightful session by Dr. Aditya Gudhate, a neurologist at KEM Hospital on Recognizing Dementia, helping participants understand the early warning signs and the importance of timely medical attention.

Dr. Aditya Gudhate says.....

Dementia often begins subtly. Some common early signs include forgetfulness, especially about recent events, difficulty finding words, misplacing objects, and struggling with familiar tasks like cooking or handling finances. People may also become confused about time or place, or show mood and personality changes, such as withdrawal, irritability, or apathy.

Recognizing these signs early is crucial. While not all memory issues indicate dementia, consistent patterns of cognitive decline should not be ignored. A timely diagnosis can help manage symptoms better, plan care, and support both patients and caregivers. The session also emphasized that dementia is not a normal part of aging and encouraged attendees to seek medical advice if they notice warning signs in loved ones.



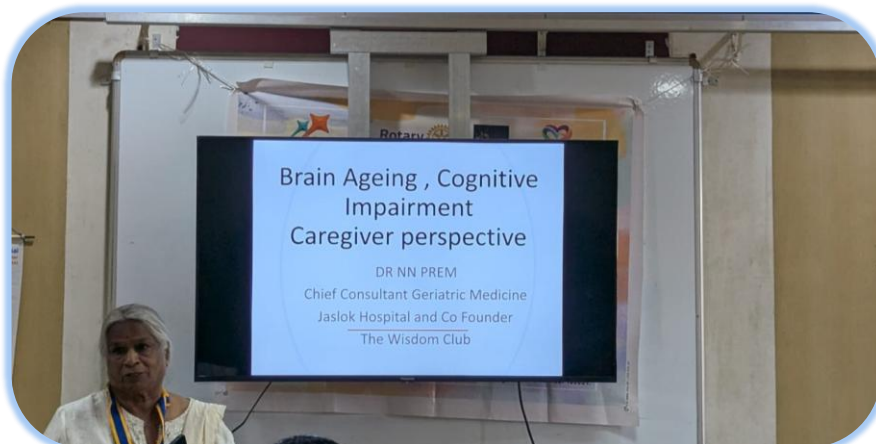


RECOGNIZING AND MANAGING DEMENTIA

In a deeply empathetic and enlightening session, Rtn. Dr. Prem Narsimhan, an experienced geriatrician, shared insights on “Dementia from a Caregiver’s Lens.” He highlighted the emotional, physical, and psychological challenges faced by caregivers who support loved ones living with dementia. Often, the burden is silent, with caregivers navigating feelings of frustration, helplessness, and grief while trying to maintain patience and compassion.

Dr. Narsimhan emphasized the need for building awareness, patience, and support systems—both medical and emotional—for caregivers. He offered practical tips such as creating structured routines, using visual aids, ensuring safety at home, and most importantly, taking care of one’s own mental health. The session served as a reminder that caring for the caregiver is just as important as caring for the patient, and reinforced the message that no one should walk the dementia journey alone.

It was a joint meeting with Rotary Club of BKC. Both sessions were highly informative, thoughtfully presented, and very well received by the audience.
