CYCLING TO SUCCESS - DISTRIBUTION OF BICYCLES AT KATTA

RCMM has been distributing bicycles every year to girl students from rural areas. There has been very encouraging results – drop outs of girl students reduced, they are scoring well and aspiring for studies beyond the school. Bicycles have proven to be wheels of change and evidence suggests they can successfully boost rural girls' enrollment in the school.

RCMM has been associated with Barrister Nath Pai Sewangan at Katta, an organization working for upliftment of school children in rural areas for last five years, donating them books, sewing machines and bicycles for needy girl students. We have donated 41 bicycles ao far. We also keep a track of academic progress of these girls.

On 9th October, 2023 RCMM distributed 7 bicycles to deserving students. Sevangan had organized a program and the bicycles were handed over to the girl students along with machine oil and air pumps to maintain the bicycles. Ten RCMM members travelled to Katta and witnessed the distribution.




WORLD MENTAL HEALTH

MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS THROUGH PAMPHLETS

Mental health includes our emotional, psychological, and social well-being. It affects how we think, feel, and act. It also helps determine how we handle stress, relate to others, and make healthy choices. Mental health is important at every stage of life, from childhood and adolescence through adulthood. Mental and physical health are equally important components of overall health. For example, depression increases the risk for many types of physical health problems, particularly long-lasting conditions like diabetes, heart disease, and stroke. Similarly, the presence of chronic conditions can increase the risk for mental illness.

Mental health awareness is the ongoing effort to reduce the stigma around mental illness and mental health conditions by sharing our personal experiences. Often, because of misconceptions about mental health and mental fitness, people often suffer in silence and their conditions go untreated.



World Mental Health Day on 10th October every year, is an international day for global mental health education, awareness and advocacy against social stigma. To bring in the awareness on mental health RCMM distributed 2000 pamphlets on 'Myths and Facts about Mental Health' in Wadala, Five Gardens and Hindu Colony areas. We took help of News Paper distributer to distribute the pamphlets bundle with the newspaper. Pamphlets were also distributed to various Psychologists and Counselors to distribute amongst their patients.

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP BOOKS AT MANGOAN SCHOOL

Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram is a NGO working for the holistic development of tribal. Since the formation in 1952 they have supported the tribal in India through projects like education, health, livelihood, sports, women empowerment and social upliftments. Kalyan Ashram runs 240 hostels, 270 schools benefitting 8828 students.

They started a school with 10 janjati students at a hutment of two rooms at Mangaon. With the increased number of students the school shifted to a new building at Utekhoi Mangaon. Now almost 450 students from Katkari and Thakur janjati are studying in 1st to 10th standard. Started from hutment of two rooms the school premises are now spread over two acres. Being residential school students from 1st to 10th standard stay at school premises. Hence they have two hostels for girls and boys to stay over. Sprawling kitchen is built to feed these students. The school is equipped with science lab, computer lab and skill based training centre. Each classroom is equipped with a projector ready to implement e- learning. The skill based education is approved by SSC board.

From 8th standard all the students get free training in skill based education program as per their liking. Almost 18 courses are covered in this program in 4 different areas of farming, home science, technical and electrical field. The students get actual working experience in these courses.

RCMM received a request for providing scholarship books (guides) for 5th and 8th standard students. Twenty three sets of books were procured from Navyug Distributors and handed over to Ashram on 30th October, 2023. Special thanks to Navyug as they offered 30% discount. This donation will definitely help Ashram to create a learning environment where their students can thrive and reach their full potential.







WAY TO INDEPENDENCE – DONATION OF ATTA CHAKKI

RCMM donated an atta chakki to Sunita Thakur on 7th October, 2023. She has one child and she had to leave her job to take care of a child as there was no support. Now the child has grown up and she wants to create a source of income through atta chakki so that she can support her husband for taking care of family's financial needs and ensure good education for the child leading to better life. RCMM wishes her all the best and hope to fulfil her dreams through an atta chakki.







RTN. MANISH GYANI ON ROTARY COMMUNITY CORPS

On 7th October, 2023 RCMM had a guest speaker Rtn. Manish Gyani to tell us all about Community Corps - A Rotary Seva-Setu with Community. He is a veteran in Rotary who led Rotary District 3141 to the highest TRF collection of 3.5 million. He was avenue director for RCC and has chartered 106 RCC in the Alpha year.

He gave a presentation on forming an RCC and why it is important for the club to associate with an RCC Rotary community Corp of their own. In his own words......

"A Rotary Community Corps (RCC) is a group of non-Rotarians who share Rotary's commitment to changing the world through service projects. RCC members plan and carry out projects in their communities in collaboration with local Rotary clubs. Sponsored by a Rotary club, an RCC leverages Rotary's network, brand, and mentorship by partnering with clubs to plan and implement service projects. RCCs increase Rotary's impact and expand its reach by bringing the knowledge and talents of local people to strengthen their community through sustainable projects.

Any person above 18 years can become a member of RCC and they have to follow 'Rotary's commitment to service'. A Rotarian cannot be a member of RCC. Urban RCC's or Rural RCC 's can be formed. One can associate with either short term or long term projects, or based on need of the community. It could also be an ongoing RCC. So RCC has a lot of flexibility.

There are almost 6000 RCC in India, out of which 225 are in Mumbai itself. RCC helps in having long term and sustainable projects. RCC enhances understanding of the local community, additional opportunities to involve members and retain members. RCC club also receives its charter, and they meet once in a month."

It was very enlightening session on RCC. RCMM may evaluate forming a RCC under it's wings. At the end Rtn. Kishore presented token of appreciation to Rtn. Manish Gyani. Rtn. Chittaranjan gave Vote of Thanks. He mentioned to have RCC in BEST Wadala, no need of going in Rural Area. Wadala Industrial estate is another area which RCMM could consider for RCC.







RTN. URMILA PRABHU ON 'YOU ARE YOUR OWN STORY'

On 21st October, 2023 RCMM had a guest speaker Rtn. Urmila Prabhu to talk on 'You are your own story'. Urmila is a committed Rotarian and a story teller as a profession. Has received many awards and has travelled abroad to train and get trained. She is also an author of several books.

She started with a small game of word association for example, when she said Rotary what came to people's mind. With the word October what comes to your mind. When you tell a story what comes to your mind.

Rtn. Urmila Prabhu narrated one of her life stories of a Britisher who had visited them. She narrated one anecdote of the British lady. It was very entertaining but at the end of it, it was a story about 'beauty is in the eyes of the Beholder'. Next she narrated another story of the snake in a woman's stomach. तसेच रूग्णालाच्या आजूबाजूला अथवा रुग्णालय परिसरात मोकळी जागा मिळाल्यास व्यसनमुक्ती केंद्र,ट्रॉमा सेंटर आणि सेंटर ऑफ एक्सलन्स सुरु करण्याचा प्रस्ताव विचाराधीन आहे. जे.जे. रुग्णालय तसेच वैद्यकीय महाविद्यालय आहे, येथे प्रशिक्षण देणे हा महत्वाचा भाग गाभा असल्याचे डॉ. पल्लवी सापळे यांनी सांगितले. याशिवाय कामा रुग्णालयात महिलांच्या अलीकडेच, कॅन्सर ओपीडी सुरुक्तरण्यात आली आहे. सध्या युरोगायनॅक आणि आयव्हिएफ केंद्राचे काम युख्दपातळीवर सुरु आहे. त्याचप्रमाणे हिसाचार पीडीत महिलांसाठी वन स्टॉप सेंटरचे काम सुरू आहे.
