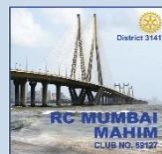

FROM PRESIDENT'S DESK



The month of September was a vibrant and fulfilling one for RCMM, marked with impactful service projects, installations, medical camps, food donations, and health awareness initiatives.

Along with our regular monthly commitments—such as providing food support to the relatives of KEM Hospital patients and supplying ration kits to 10 TB patients—we also undertook several noteworthy projects.

- **Installations:** During this month Installation for the year 2025-26 was carried out for interact clubs of J B Vachha School for Parsee girls, Chatrapati Shivaji Vidyalaya and Rotaract Club for King Circle Matunga.
- **Medical Camp at Dadar Vidya Mandir:** A comprehensive camp covering general check-ups, dental care, and eye check-ups was organized for 175 students. It was a highly satisfying and meaningful initiative.
- **Beach Clean-Up Drive:** On 7th September 2025, the very next day after Anant Chaturdashi, RCMM joined hands with the Rotary Clubs of Bombay Uptown and Wadala East for a beach clean-up at Shivaji Park beach.
- **Organ Donation Awareness Walk:** Rotary Club of Bombay Uptown organized this walk at Five Gardens, Parsee Colony. Rotary Club of Mumbai Mahim also jointly participated in it. Rtn. Dr. Sunil Keswani enlightened participants on the importance of organ donation on how and when it can be done.
- **World Heart Day Initiative:** On 28th September 2025, in collaboration with the cardiologists of Gleneagles Hospital, RCMM organized a 'Walk with Doc' and CPR training at Udyan Ganesh, Shivaji Park. Doctors not only guided participants through the walk but also imparted valuable knowledge on heart care and conducted live CPR demonstrations for emergency preparedness.
- **Knowledge Quest:** We co-hosted this inter-school competition where CSV School and Neral Vidya Mandir participated. Neral Vidya Mandir proudly reached the semi-finals.
- **UDAAN for Interactors:** Our CSV Interactors participated in the Drawing Competition and received participation certificates.

September truly highlighted RCMM's dedication to service, collaboration, and community impact, strengthening our mission of serving society with compassion and action.

RATION DISTRIBUTION UNDER PRADHAN MANTRI TB MUKT BHARAT ABHIYAN

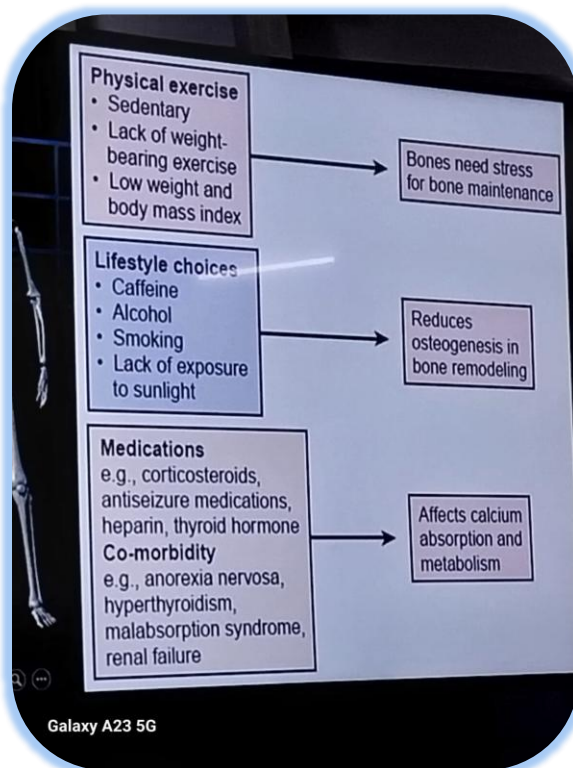

SUJATA YARDI ON OSTEOPOROSIS

As part of our ongoing commitment to promoting health awareness among members and the community, our Rotary Club invited Ms. Sujata Yardi, a renowned expert in health and wellness, to speak on the important and often overlooked topic of osteoporosis. With her extensive knowledge and practical insights, she helped us better understand this silent condition that affects bone health, especially in aging populations. Her session aimed to educate members on early prevention, lifestyle adjustments, and the importance of timely diagnosis and treatment.

Ms. Yardi's presentation was clear, well-structured, and highly engaging. She captivated the audience with her command over the subject and practical approach to explaining osteoporosis—a condition that often goes unnoticed until it becomes severe. She stressed the importance of bone density screening after the age of 50, highlighting how early detection, regular exercise, a balanced diet, and necessary lifestyle changes can significantly reduce the risk of osteoporosis. Many people, she pointed out, tend to neglect bone health until it's too late. She also shared valuable tips on how to care for individuals already suffering from severe osteoporosis, making the session not only educational but also deeply relevant. The talk left a strong impact on our members, many of whom expressed interest in inviting her again for a follow-up session. Her confidence, clarity, and approachable style made a lasting impression on everyone present.



IDEAL STUDY APP DISTRIBUTION AT SANT VAMAN MAHARAJ SCHOOL

Manora, a taluka in Washim, Amaravati, has long lagged behind in economic, social, and educational development—both within the district and across Maharashtra. Amidst this backdrop, Sant Vaman Maharaj English School was founded 13 years ago by a visionary young man, Abhijit Deshmukh, with a mission to transform the region through quality education.

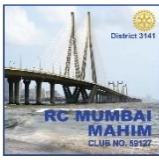

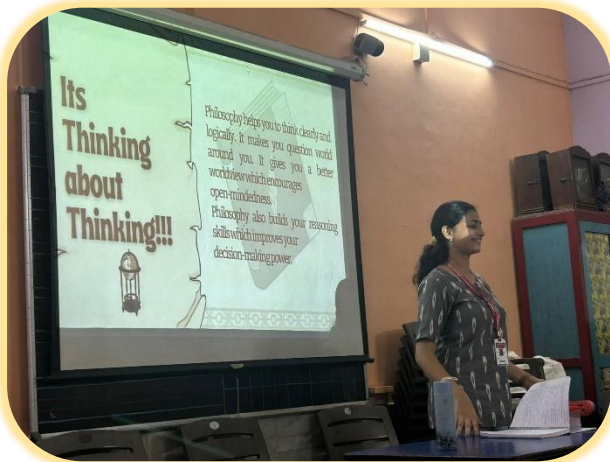

BEYOND THINKING - A SESSION BY ROTARACTORS AT MPS

On 19th September, 2025 the Rotaract Club of Ramnarain Ruia College organized an interactive workshop titled *"Beyond Thinking"* at Matunga Premier School. BEYOND THINKING - A SESSION BY ROTARACTORS AT DVM

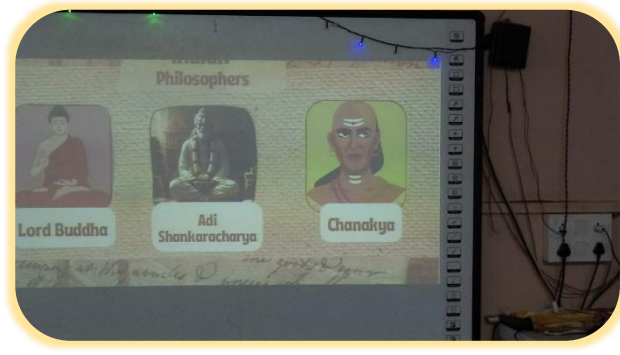

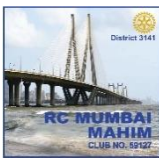

WALK WITH DOC & CPR TRAINING

After the walk, everyone gathered in the pandal next to Udyan Ganesh Mandir – special thanks to the trustees for making the space available despite the rain. Doctors from Gleneagles Hospital – Dr. Rahul Gupta, Dr. Swaroop Pal, Dr. Charan Lanjewar, and Dr. V. M. Reddy – shared valuable insights on heart health. They emphasized the importance of regular exercise, balanced diet, avoiding smoking and excessive alcohol, managing stress, monitoring blood pressure, sugar and cholesterol, and going for timely health check-ups. They also stressed that “prevention is better than cure” and small lifestyle changes can greatly reduce the risk of heart disease.

Rtn. Dr. Nilesh Satbhai highlighted the importance of organ donation, while Rtn. Sunita explained the need for registering as an organ donor and the importance of informing family members about one’s decision.

This was followed by a hands-on CPR training session, where doctors demonstrated the technique and participants practiced to understand the correct mechanics of saving lives during emergencies.

All speakers were felicitated by Rotary and Shri Udyan Ganesh Seva Samiti. Rtn. Suryakumar proposed the Vote of Thanks, and the event concluded with snacks and fellowship.

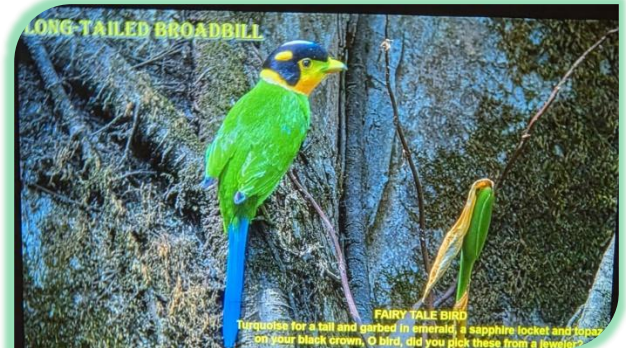
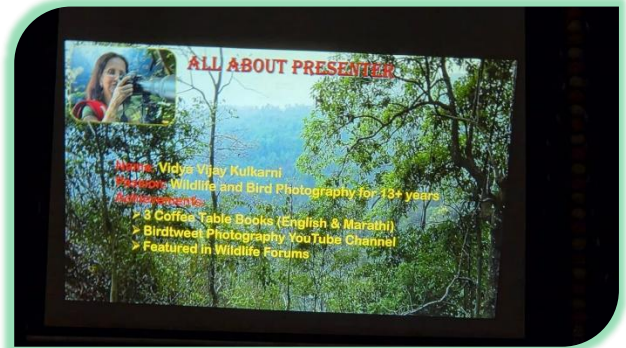
