At Dadar station thousands of commuters travel during the day and it can help medical staff at the station to give emergency CPR to patients suffering from cardiac arrest and save their lives with timely help.

Both these projects are a perfect example that if we work towards particular goals, we do get support from the universe and it helps us in finding right people who help us complete the goals.

Under Rtn. Sunita's leadership, we successfully organized an online Organ Donation Awareness webinar. Dr. Nilesh Satbhai and Rtn. Dr. Pallavi Saple, for their insightful contributions as panelists.






DONATION OF DIGITAL MICROSCOPE TO KEM HOSPITAL

DONATION OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)

Rtn. Chittaranjan Datar's heartfelt desire was to donate an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) specifically to Dadar Station, driven by personal tragedy—he lost his mother to cardiac arrest due to the unavailability of an AED at the station during an emergency. Despite RCMM's efforts to secure permissions from the Railways hitting roadblocks, a breakthrough came when Rtn. Shital, through her NGO connections, facilitated a meeting between RCMM members Rtns. Dhananjay and Suryakumar, along with PR Pradnya, and Mr. Pandey, Station Master of Dadar. Recognizing the urgent need for an AED at Dadar Station, frequented by almost 10 lakhs commuters, RCMM pledged their donation.

On 8th March, 2024 the AED at Dadar Station was inaugurated in the presence of RCMM members. Prior to the inauguration, hands-on training was provided to railway personnel to ensure effective handling during emergencies.

DONATION OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)

An AED is a portable electronic device crucial in diagnosing and treating life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias, enabling prompt intervention in situations like sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). Equipped with user-friendly interfaces and voice prompts, AEDs empower bystanders or trained individuals to administer lifesaving treatment even without extensive medical training.

In March, RCMM successfully completed yet another impactful project, enhancing the railway personnel's capability to manage medical emergencies efficiently. Special gratitude to Rtn. Chittaranjan for his enduring patience, now finding solace as his longstanding wish is fulfilled. Station Master has promised to put up boards all over the station indicating the availability of AED and creating the awareness.

DONATION OF WHEEL CHAIRS AT DADAR STATION

A cheque was issued in the name of the hospital where he receives treatment, and it was collected by his son.





RATION DISTRIBUTION UNDER PRADHAN MANTRI TB MUKT BHARAT

Under the Pradhan Mantri TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyan, ration distribution plays a crucial role in supporting individuals undergoing tuberculosis (TB) treatment. The initiative ensures that TB patients receive nutritional support through the provision of essential food items, aiding their recovery and improving treatment outcomes. By addressing nutritional needs alongside medical interventions, the program aims to combat TB more effectively and reduce its burden on affected individuals and communities.

In continuation from last month, on 16th March, 2024 ration was distributed to 16 patients at BMC dispensary, near Shree Cinema, behind Goa Portuguesa restaurant, City Light. Rtns. Dr. Gurmit, Dr. Hemangee and Dr. Supriya personally distributed the ration to the patients. Hope this helps the patients to regain their health and lead the normal life.




ORGAN DONATION AWARENESS SESSION

Organ donation awareness in India is a critical issue that demands attention. Despite significant progress, misconceptions and cultural barriers still hinder donation rates. Increasing awareness through education campaigns and addressing concerns surrounding organ donation can potentially save countless lives and improve healthcare outcomes across the nation. RCMM had organized the Organ Donation Awareness Session on Zoom on 16th March, 2024. Almost 50 plus people attended the session.

PR. Pradnya Sabnis opened the session and welcomed DG Arun Bhargava and all panelists. DG Bhargava congratulated RCMM for arranging the Organ Donation Awareness webinar which is of utmost importance to the Society at large. Rtn. Sunita, Coordinator and ardent propagator for organ donation welcomed the panelists viz. Dr Pallavi Saple, Dr Nilesh Satbhai, Mr Sunil Deshpande invited for the programme. Rtn Sunita reiterated that the selflessness of Organ Donor is an invaluable gift for transition in the life of Recipient. Organ donation awareness has transformative power. It is a passionate venture and RCMM members have dedication for the purpose.

Rtn. Vandana then introduced the panelists who are all Rotarians. The doctors are medical experts in their fields and have been contributing towards organ donation/transplants. Rtn Sunil Deshpande is an organ donation activist and passionate about spreading awareness by adopting different ways and means.







ORGAN DONATION AWARENESS SESSION

Rtn Sunita put forth certain questions to panelists on Process of organ donation, Legal structure, Cost involved, Types of donation etc. The gist of experts' opinions as well as experiences is given below:

Dr Pallavi Saple: She has opined that the Robust Transplant programme is not in place at Public Hospitals. However, road map has been laid out and Transplant coordinator has been appointed by Govt. Agency. While the process of donation in case of accident victim has to be taken up with relatives, the harvesting of organs and their transportation to recipient/s is also herculean task. The whole process requires motivation of doctors, nurses, other staff involved apart from formalities to be complied. As on date, consent of relatives is necessary before harvesting the organ of the donor as per extant law. However, the digitalization of the donor's pledge would have to be done and then, changes in Law would follow. No incentives are allowed to Donor's family as per Law, but homage to departing soul of donor by Govt. official at funeral is allowed. Dr Pallavi spoke about different types of donations viz. (i)Live Donation in case of liver, kidney (ii) Cadaver donation after death (iii) Body donation to hospital for study/research (iv)Brainstem donor ie. ventilated patient. She is positive that more transplants have to be done at Public Hospital to reduce the cost of this procedure. She emphasized the relevance of Rotary to take up awareness programme in a big way to remove misconceptions, social/cultural inhibitions from the minds of public.







ORGAN DONATION AWARENESS SESSION

Dr Satbhai: He being a Plastic Surgeon and hand specialist has expressed dire need of organ donation awareness and more particularly, external organ donation. There has been huge waiting list for organ requirement and the patient suffer the quality of life due to loss of hand, foot etc. He has informed that even tissues can be donated. Organ donation can transform Tragedy into Opportunity since it has positive impact on patient as well as family. Donation of external organs after death results into body mutilation which inhibits family from social point of view. He has expressed that the surgical/medical cost of implant has been high. Since the patients are from working class, the costs are prohibitive. Hospitals endeavor to subsidize these costs by resorting to crowd funding, approaching NGOs etc. The patient has to consume immuno-suppressants life long, resulting into high level of post-operative care. Empowering Govt. hospitals for such procedures will reduce the costs. He expressed the need to keep creating awareness and to encourage even for donation of tissues such as bones, tendons, heart valves etc. He has mentioned that India has superseded in hand transplants in the world, in 8 years span time but has not been able to remove doubts/misconceptions about donation of external organs.

Mr. Sunil Deshpande: He is a Rotarian from Pune North and passionate activist for Organ Donation. He has undertaken padayatra of 4000 kms in urban and mainly in rural areas during 2016-2020 for spreading awareness about organ donation. He has so far reached 50000 people in Maharashtra. Apart from padayatras, he has given lectures in schools/colleges, temples, old age homes etc. He believes that organ donation has to become public movement which would change traditions according to social requirement. He highlighted that Pune Rotary club would be starting 'Activists training programme' on a large scale from next year. He stressed the need to include organ donation in Rotary International's Thrust Area to percolate it further.

The webinar was made interesting by showing Videos of patients and families.

At the end, Rtn. Sunita expressed her sincere gratitude to all esteemed panelists and valuable insights provided by them. Although there have been complexities in organ donation, it has profound impact on Donor's families due to contribution to noble cause. She has advocated commitment to this vital cause which will carry forward awareness in the communities. She thanked all participants and closed the session.









ORGAN DONATION AWARENESS SESSION

Subsequent to the awareness session Mr. Sunil Deshpande along with Federation of Organ and Body Donation and 'Rotary Club of Poona North' in association with Jupiter Hospital had organized a Walkathon on 23rd March, 2024 at 6am at Pune.

Rtn. Prakash Samudra represented RCMM by actively participating in the Walkathon.

VOCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD

The Vocational Excellence Award is typically given to individuals who have demonstrated outstanding skill, dedication, and achievement in a specific vocational or occupational field. RCMM selected Dr. Ajay Darekar for Vocational Excellence Award for his remarkable dedication to helping students and youths self-discover their true potential through creative communication, enthusiasm, and empathetic listening. At 18, he founded the Versatile Educaare System, aiming to cultivate tomorrow's leaders. Through initiatives like the VYEP program, he has empowered over 10,000 youths to realize their goals and aspirations.

Dr. Ajay Darekar was honoured at RCMM's weekly meeting held on 23rd March, 2024, where he was presented with the Vocational Excellence Award in recognition of his exceptional contributions and achievements.





Dr. Ajay Darekar shared his story with RCMM members and what motivated him doing what he currently does.

He coming from a Mumbai's Slum background, had seen life struggle at a tender age. Being a School Topper yet failed to Select Right Career at Right Time due to lack of proper guidance made him realize the core problem of other Youths and hence just at the age of 18 (in 2004), he founded Verstaile Educaare System with only 2 students and with a game changing vision of Creating Leaders of Tomorrow.

He believes current education system is not enough to build tomorrow's Entrepreneurs. They need to develop several skills and habits to succeed in life. Hence, over the years, he has trained more than 10,000 students' to self-discover themselves and achieve their Goals.





VOCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD







Dr. Ajay Darekar emphasized the importance of having a purpose in life to add meaning and fulfillment. He advocated for a structured approach to discovering one's purpose, highlighting the significance of setting up a vision, mission, values, and goals. In a straightforward manner, he elucidated the definitions of these key elements: goals, mission, vision, and values.

During the session, Dr. Darekar encouraged participants to reflect on their surroundings and contemplate the purpose of their own lives. This introspective exercise aimed to prompt individuals to delve deeper into their personal aspirations and motivations.

Overall, the session proved to be engaging and enlightening for the RCMM members, who expressed satisfaction with the selection of Dr. Ajay Darekar for the Vocational Excellence Award.



JJ first public hosp to offer trans voice surgery

MUMBAI: JJ hospital becomes the first state-run hospital to offer transgender voice surgery as they rope in Dr Nupur Nerurkar, ENT surgeon from Bombay Hospital, first in the state to do the surgery. The surgery -

Wendlers Glottoplasty - is a voice-changing surgery introduced by a German surgeon, Jurgen Wendler, which helps achieve a feminine voice for transgender persons.

Dr Pallavi Saple, dean of the JJ group of hospitals, said, "The ENT department will have an outpatient service for patients wanting feminine voice. The procedure will be under the supervision of Dr Nerurkar, who will be doing the surgeries and guiding our doctors.'

Dr Nerurkar, who has performed around 60 voice surgeries, said that when a trans person wants to become a man, within six months of getting tes-

tosterone injection, the voice becomes masculine. It is the male wanting to become female where voice becomes a hindrance. "Trans persons wanting to feminise their voice rely on voice modulations. They also face vocal fatigue and mental stress. Voice change is the only permanent solution," she said.


