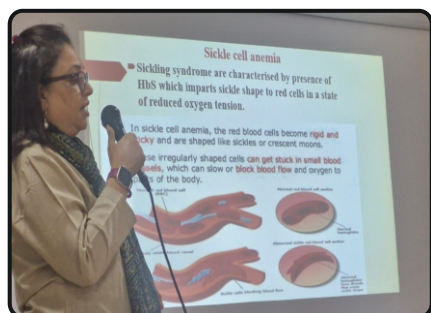

Club News & Service Projects

Rotary Club of Rajkot organized the "Gift of Mobility Prabha Foot Camp"

at Shree Anantji Vaidnagar Boarding, Rajkot, aiming to address the mobility challenges faced by the differently-abled. The camp provided essential foot-related solutions, helping restore dignity and improve the quality of life for many individuals. Chaired by Chandresh Manwani, the project was carried out with a budget of ₹7,50,000, significantly impacting the lives of the beneficiaries.

Rotary Club of Surendranagar hosted its third annual Open Gujarat Elite Chess Tournament

at M.P. Shah Commerce College, in memory of late Shri Bhikha bhai Lobi. The event saw 142 participants from across Gujarat, competing in Open, Senior Citizens, Women's, and Under 15 categories. Winners received cash prizes and trophies, further boosting the public image of the Rotary Club.

Rotary Club of Navsari organized several community service events

They hosted 45 senior citizens at Dandi Beach for games, bhajans, and Garba. On 4th October, they spent time with mentally challenged children at Balaji Mandi Buddhist Children School. A Mega Pusti Rally on 5th October collected donations for the needy. On 21st October, old sarees and dupattas were donated to children at Mamta Mandir. The club also distributed 100 school bags to underprivileged children on 22nd October and organized a Sarv Rog Nidan Mega Camp on 27th October, benefiting 462 people in Karambele Village.

Rotary Club of Anand Milkcity encourage tree planting

The Tree Plantation Major Project promotes the slogan "Ek Ped Apnon ke Bye", encouraging tree planting on special occasions. This year, high-quality tree guards and a local NGO ensure better survival rates. The project began with a donation of INR 1 LK for planting 10 trees at a school. Efforts are also underway to redesign tree guards for reuse in future plantations.

Rotary Club of Surat West distributed 240 sweaters to needy students

at SMC School No 199 in GDC area of Pandesara, Surat.

The Rotary Club of Bhavnagar Roundtown organized a Resin Art Workshop

aimed at teaching art to participants at a very low cost. Held at the club's hall, the workshop was conducted by qualified faculty and saw the participation of 20 ladies. The project, with a cost of ₹15,000, provided an opportunity for women to learn a new skill in resin art.

The Rotary Club of Baroda Jawaharnagar held a session awareness

with 45 students from Maa Bharti School to introduce them to the 4-Way Test. The students were encouraged to apply its principles daily, and pamphlets were distributed for reference. The session was led by Rtn. PP Anita Jandali, PP Dr. Jayant Sastry, and Hon. Sec. PP Hemang Vahia.
