It was the most important meeting of the year; it was District Governor's Official Club Visit. DG Tushar Shah and first lady Rtn. Nehal Shah visited Rotary Club Bhavnagar on 29th November, 2024.

The day started with warm welcome and then they visited some of the significant projects of Rotary Club Bhavnagar. Back to back meetings were scheduled with Club President, Hon. Secretary and President Elect followed by luncheon meeting with board of directors, committee chairperson, past president, district office bearers, Rotarctors, Intrectors and Inner Wheel Members. During evening DG visited one of the star projects of RC Bhavnagar "Ray of Hope".

During meeting, DG Tushar Shah delivered an excellent speech starting with examples of ways in which Rotary can do the Magic to the world. Process to follow for registration ;

1. After opening the link, the member has to login through his registered email ID in the user name. (Password Rotary@1234) has to be entered.
2. If anyone does not know Rotary's email ID, then enter the registered mobile number in the forget option, then your registered email ID / user name will be found.
3. After login, your profile will be displayed on the screen in which the member can change his mobile number, date of birth and address if there is any change. (Changes cannot be made again after final submission.)
4. You can upload your photo in two ways for the photo that will be printed in the ID card. (You can also upload digital photos from your storage or by clicking the camera.)
5. This information will only be sufficient for the Rotary District 3060 Membership ID Card.
6. Any member who knows his registered email ID or mobile number should contact his club president.
7. Every member should update their profile.
8. Only members who have a registered member ID on Rotary.org are eligible for a District 3060 Membership ID card.
