Rotary youth exchange is unique program of Rotary International, It helps student to truly become global citizens. Exchanges of students ages 15-19 are sponsored by Rotary clubs worldwide.

What are the benefits ?

Exchange students unlock their true potential to:

- Develop lifelong leadership skills
- Learn a new language and culture
- Build lasting friendships with young people from around the world
- Become a global citizen

How long do exchanges last?

- **Long-term exchanges** last a full academic year, and students attend local schools and live with multiple host families.
- **Short-term exchanges** last from several days to three months and are often structured as camps, tours, or homestays that take place when school is not in session.

What are the costs?

Room and board are provided, as well as any school fees. Each program varies, but students are usually responsible for:

- Round-trip airfare
- Travel insurance
- Travel documents (such as passports and visas)
- Spending money and any additional travel or tours
