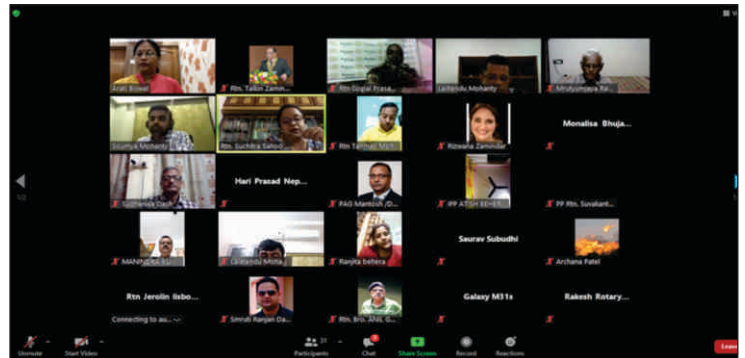
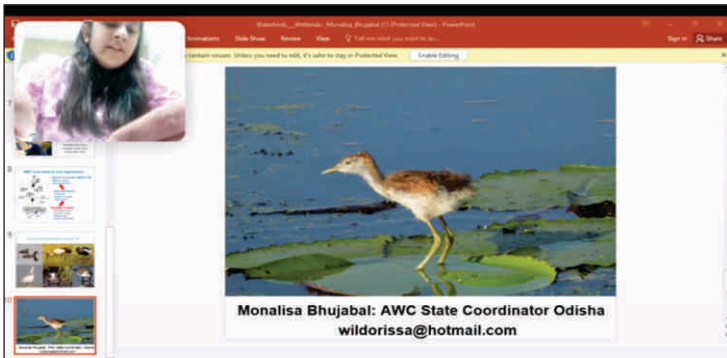

FEBRUARY PROJECTS

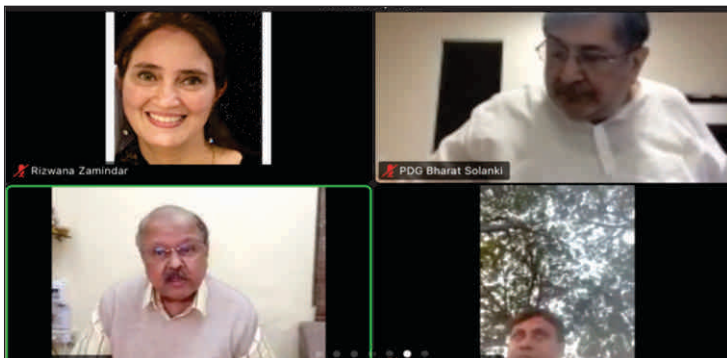

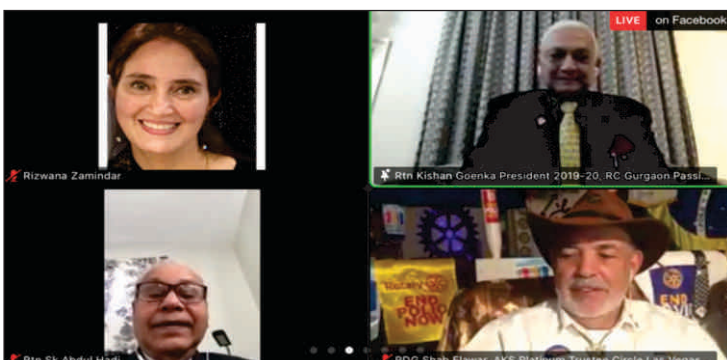

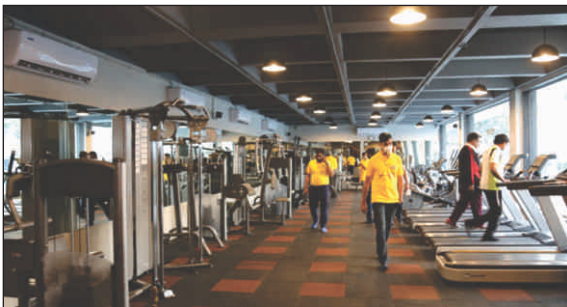

District Rally Pravas

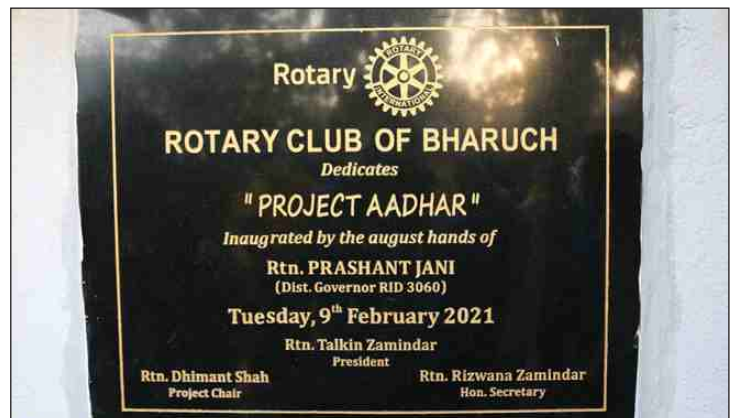

Her poetry for children (written by her when she was a child) was selected for the publication and awarded by Hindi sahitya Parishad. Bouquet of 25 innocent beautiful

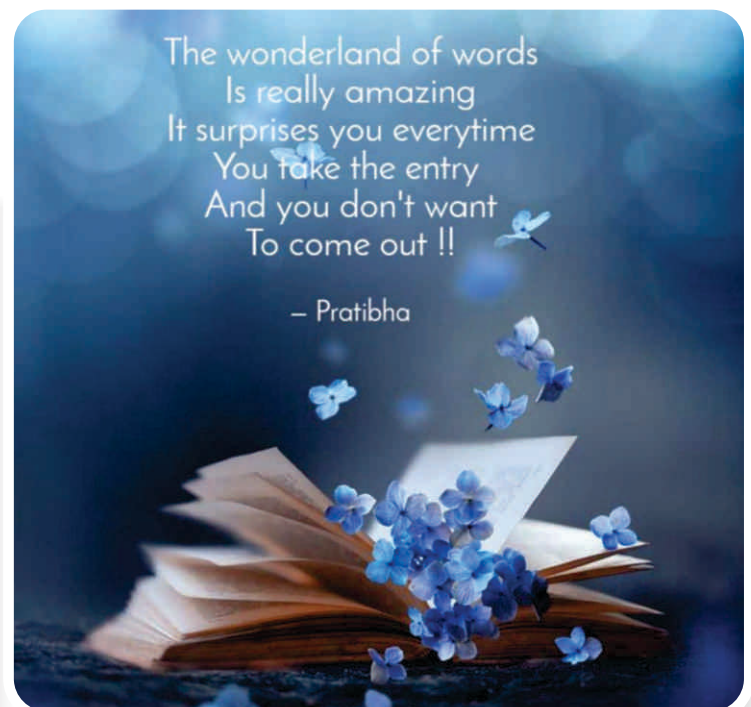

Her articles, poems, stories and letters were published in reputed magazines like Good House Keeping, Ideal Home, Sakhi, Women's era.

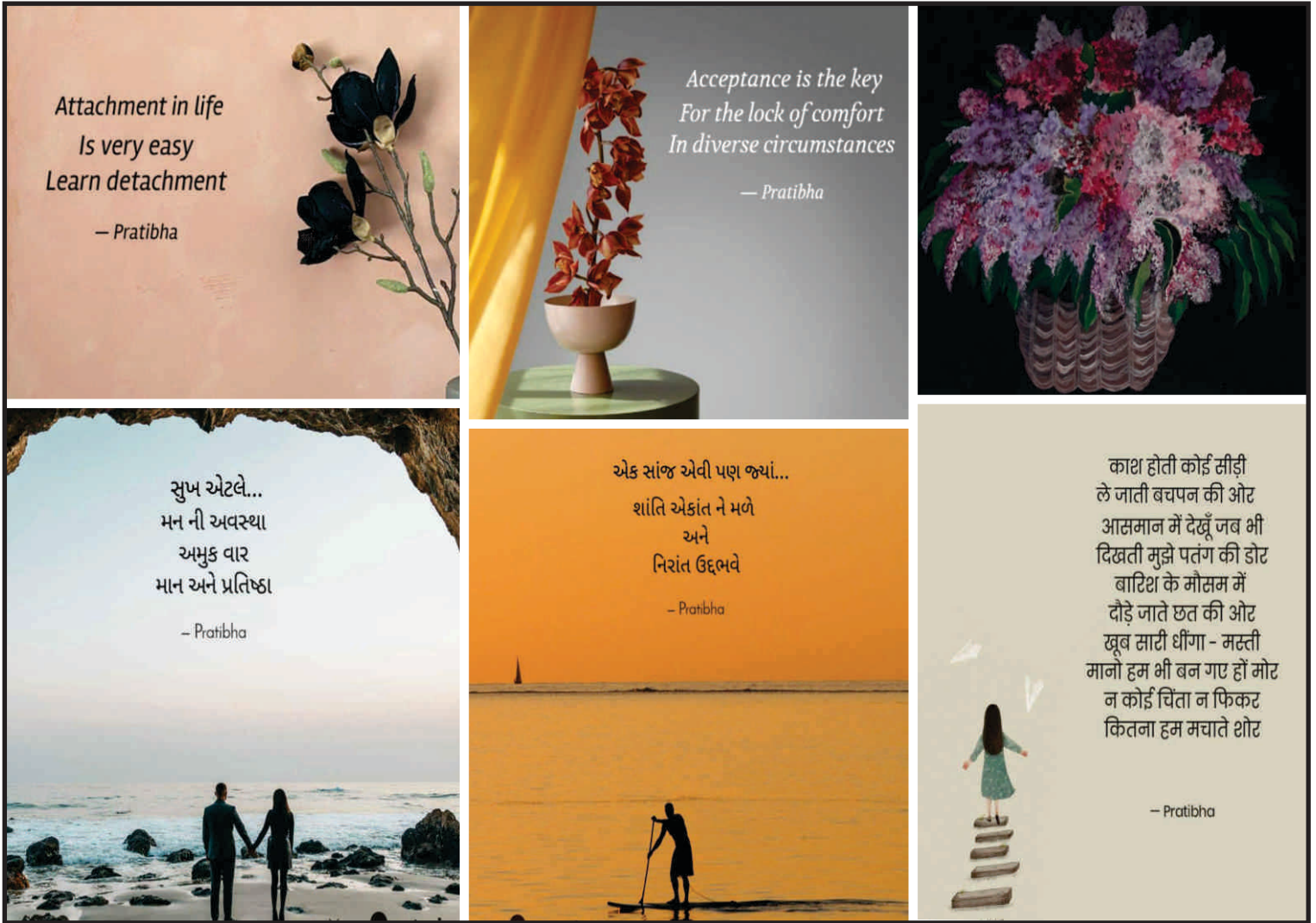
