



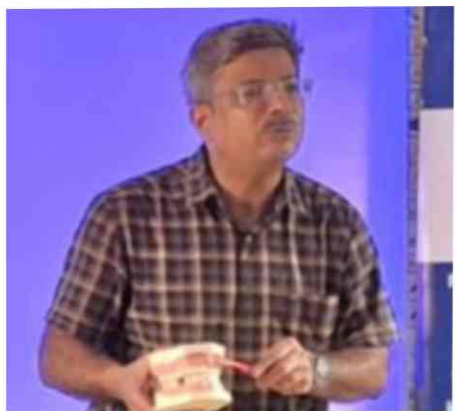

Rotary Club of Bharuch was chartered on 19th June 1944 by the eminent citizens of that era. It's most notable that the then British governor of Bombay Presidency was present as chief guest. The charter president was Sardar Mansinhji Rana-Thakore Saheb of

Kerwada who later on went on to become Shipping Minister of India as well as the first speaker of the Gujarat Legislative Assembly. The club has left a deep impression on the psyche of the people of Bharuch through last 8 decades because of the selfless services rendered by Rotarians spanning 4-5 generations. Most notable are the various state of the art permanent projects like MIPRYC, Shantivan Crematorium, PD Shroff Rotary Diagnostic center, Pay & use toilet blocks to name a few amongst many. R C Bharuch over the years has always been in the forefront to help the victims of disasters.

The club also has been playing a pivotal role in extending its finest and most effective services during the pandemic. The efforts made by the club for Polio

Donors' impact celebrated at special events during 2024 Rotary International Convention

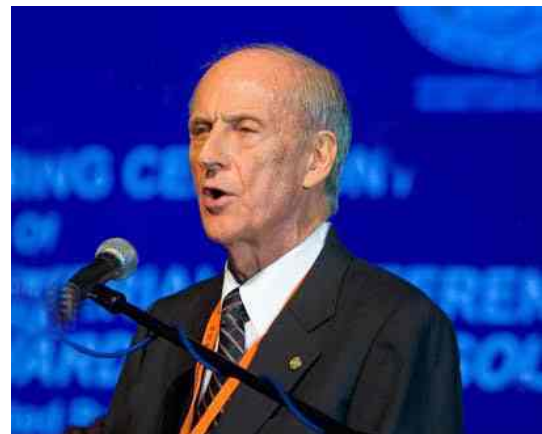

K4Knowledge: Qinghai Tibetan Plateau

The **Qinghai Tibetan Plateau** is a vast elevated Plateau, stretches approximately **1000 km north to south and 2500 km east to west**. It is **world's highest and largest Plateau** above sea level. It covers an area of 25 lakh sq. Km. It has an average elevation exceeding **14800 ft** and surrounded by mountain ranges that harbor world's two highest summits, **Mount Aversr and K2**. It is often referred as the **"ROOF OF THE WORLD"**. Plateau contains water of drainage basins of streams and rivers in surrounding regions. This includes 3 longest rivers in Asia. Its **thousands of glaciers**, geographical and ecological features serve as a **"WATER TOWER" for storing water**. It is sometimes termed as **"Third Pole"** because its ice fields contain the **largest reserves** of **fresh water** outside the **pole regions**.

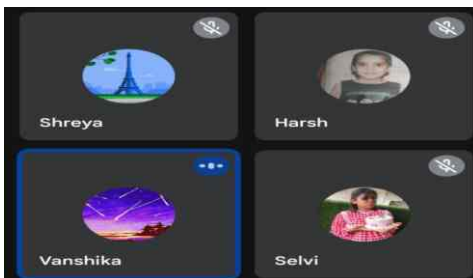
